CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES DWIGHT C. MOORHEAD

The Denver Regional Office filed a complaint on December 2 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado seeking to enjoin Dwight C. Moorhead, former vice chairman of the board of directors of Petro-Lewis Corporation of Denver, Colorado, from future violations of the securities laws. The complaint alleged that Moorhead traded in the common stock of Petro-Lewis in December 1983 and January 1984 while in possession of material, nonpublic information about the financial condition of Petro-Lewis and its public oil and gas partnerships, in violation of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, a consent was tendered to the Court whereby Moorhead, without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, consented to the permanent injunction. (SEC v. Dwight C. Moorhead, Civil Action No. 85-2555, Denver, Colorado). (LR-10948)

CRIMINAL CONTEMPT HEARING SCHEDULED AGAINST ARTHUR B. JACOBY AND JOSEPH J. PAVLICO

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on November 19 Chief Judge Robert D. Potter, U.S. District Court for the Western District of North Carolina, entered an Order to Show Cause why Arthur B. Jacoby and Joseph J. Pavlico should not be held in criminal contempt based upon wilfull violations of the Court's orders. The orders, among other things, restrained them and Financial & Business Services, Inc. (FBSI) from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws, established a trust over the assets of FBSI and its affiliates and prohibited them from disposing of assets or altering the books and records of FBSI and its affiliates.

The Commission's application alleges that Jacoby and Pavlico wilfully violated the order by transferring approximately \$135,000 to their own use or to the benefit of another corporate entity and altered the books and records of FBSI.

On September 23, the defendants consented to a permanent injunction without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, and also consented to the appointment of a permanent receiver over FBSI and its affiliates. The receiver has also filed for contempt charges. Both applications have been consolidated and are scheduled for hearing on November 25. (SEC v. Arthur B. Jacoby and Joseph J. Pavlico, Misc. Action No. 762-P WDNC). (LR-10947)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

JOSEPH D. STEWART SENTENCED

The Atlanta Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Western District of Tennessee announced that on November 15 Joseph D. Stewart of Memphis, Tennessee was sentenced to four years probation and 60 days imprisonment, to be served in a half-way house, based upon his September 13 guilty plea of two counts of securities fraud. One count of mail fraud was dismissed.

The indictment alleged that from approximately May 1, 1982 and continuing to May 1984, Stewart engaged in a scheme to defraud by converting the funds of investors entrusted to him for the purchase of securities to his own use and benefit, making false statements concerning the use of the funds and earnings purportedly being derived from such funds and issuing promissory notes to lull the investors into a false sense of security.
