OPEN MEETING - WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 1994 - 10:00 A.M.

The ambject matter of the February 9 open meeting will be:

Consideration of the reproposal of rules implementing the large trader reporting rection of the Market Reform Act of 1990. The reproposed rules would require a person that effects significant quantities of transactions in publicly traded securities to the Form 13H with the Commission disclosing such person's identity and accounts; require broker-dealers that carry accounts to maintain records of transactions effected by or for such person's accounts; and require such broker-dealers to report to the Commission upon request, transactions effected by or for such person's accounts. 2. Consideration of a release that would discuss the need to establish recordkeeping and reporting requirements for brokers and dealers that operate automated trading systems. The release would propose for comment a rule that would require registered broker-dealer sponsors of these systems to maintain participant, volume and transaction records, and to report system activity periodically to the Commission. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

DECISION BARRING PETER CALCUTTA FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge barring Peter C. Calcutta from association with any broker or dealer has become final. Calcutta was the chief trader and an owner of Monmouth Investments, Inc. Among other actions, Calcutta engaged in fraudulent sales practices, sold unregistered securities, and fraudulently time and date stamped 600 to 300 order tickets to make it appear as if there were heavy and active trading on the first day of the aftermarket trading of Beres Industries stock. The law judge found that Calcutta's actions violated Sections 5(a), 5(e) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rules 10b-5 and 10b-6 thereunder. Calcutta previously had consented to an order of inj motion and disgorgement in connection with these activities. (Rel. 34-33519)

RICHARD PAUL CONSENTS TO A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

The Commission instituted and settled an administrative proceeding against Richard L. Paul, forme ly President and Chief Operating Officer of American Pioneer Savings Bank, a new defunct savings and loan based in Orlando, Florida.

Without admitting or denying the facts, opinions or findings therein, Paul consented to an Order Instituting Proceeding Pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Findings and Order of the Commission. The Commission determined that American Pioneer's loan loss provision was understated for the quarterly period ended September 30, 1988, resulting in overstated net income as reflected in financial statements for that quarter. American Pioneer included the financial statements in offering circular supplements used in a public offering of subordinated capital notes of American Pioneer. The Commission determined that Paul knew, should have known, or was reckless in not knowing of the inadequate provision, but, nevertheless, allowed American Pioneer to use the financial statements in the offer and sale of American Pioneer is an evidence of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act.

The Order requires that Paul permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violations, and committing or causing any future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act. (Rel. 33-7043; AAE Rel. 524)

RICHARD SWANN CONSENTS TO A CEASE AND DESIST GRDER

The Commission instituted and settled an administrative proceeding against Richard R. Swann, formerly Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of American Pioneer Savings Bank, a now defunct savings and loan based in Orlando, Florida.

Without admitting or denying the facts, opinions or findings therein, Swann consented to an Order Instituting Proceeding Pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Findings and Order of the Commission. The Commission determined that American Pioneer's loan loss provision was understated for the quarterly period ended September 30, 1988, resulting in overstated net income as reflected in financial statements for that quarter. American Pioneer included the financial statements in offering circular supplements used in a public offering of subordinated capital notes of American Pioneer. The Commission determined that Swann knew, should have known, or was reckless in not knowing of the inadequate provision but, nevertheless, allowed American Pioneer to use the financial statements in the offer and sale of American Pioneer's securities in violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act.

The Order requires that Swann permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violations, and committing or causing any future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act. (Rel. 33-7044; AAE Rel. 525)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SMITH BAPNEY SHEARSON APPRECIATION FUND INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 22, 1994 to request a hearing on an application filed by Smith Barney Shearson Appreciation Fund Inc., et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would amend previous orders that exempted certain Shearson Lehman Brothers applicants from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The previous orders permit certain Shearson investment companies to issue multiple classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities and assess and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on redemptions of shares. The present order is necessary because of the sale of the assets of Shearson to Primerica Corporation and Primerica's subsidiary, Smith Barney Shearson Inc. (formerly, Smith Barney, Harris Upham & Co. Incorporated). (Rel. IC-20042 - January 28)

SAFECO LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 22, 1994 to request a hearing on an application by SAFECO Life Insurance Company, SAFECO Separate Account C (Separate Account) and PNMR Securities, Inc. for an order pursuant to Section 6(c)

of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Separate Account under certain individual deferred variable annuity contracts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, and its nonutility subsidiary companies, CSW Energy, Inc., CSW Development-I, Inc., Polk Power Partners, L.P., Polk Power GP, Inc., ARK/CSW Development Partnership and a proposed subsidiary, CSW Mulberry, Inc., to issue, sell and acquire 1,000 shares, no par value, of CSW Mulberry, Inc. common stock; to sell partnership interests in amounts up to \$160 million; and to obtain letters of credit or to provide guaranties of up to \$50 million in connection with the construction and financing of a cogeneration project located in Polk County, Florida. PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-74) to append geographic indicators to market maker identifiers disseminated over the <u>NASD's OTC Bulletin Board Service</u>. The <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-CHX-93-19) to establish rules for an institutional trading system, called the Match Market Exchange Facility. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of January 31. (Rel. 34-33542)

The <u>Participants Trust Company</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PTC-92-16) relating to margin levels for collateralized mortgage obligations. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of January 31. (Rel. 34-33546)

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by <u>The Depository Trust Company</u> (SR-DTC-93-08) and the <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-NSCC-93-07) that approves a Netting Contract and Limited Cross-Guarantee Agreement. (Rel. 34-33548)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-89-04) filed by <u>The Options Clearing Corporation</u> to convert OCC's Index Option Escrow Receipt Program from pilot to permanent status. (Rel. 34-33549)
