RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

EXTENSION OF COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RULE 2A-7

The Commission has extended from April 6, 1994 to May 6, 1994 the period for public comment on proposed amendments to Rule 2a-7 under the Investment Company Act and related rules and forms. Rule 2a-7 is the rule under which money market funds are regulated.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SLH OHIO MUNICIPALS FUND

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that SLH Ohio Municipals Fund has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-20177 - March 30)

SLH MICHIGAN MUNICIPALS FUND

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that SLH Michigan Municipals Fund has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-20178 - March 30)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), a registered holding company, and its nonutility subsidiary company, AEP Energy Services, Inc. (AEP Energy), for AEP to make additional investments in AEP Energy, through December 31, 1995, in the amount of \$5 million for preliminary development activities associated with its consulting business. AEP and AEP Energy also propose to expand the current scope of financial commitment of AEP to include the issuance of guarantees or assumption of liabilities, through December 31, 1995, by AEP on behalf of AEP Energy to unaffiliated third parties in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$25 million. MONONGAHELA POWER COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued granting a proposal by Monongahela Power Company, The Potomac Edison Company, and West Penn Power Company (Applicants), each an electric utility subsidiary Allegheny Power System, Inc. (Allegheny), a registered holding company. Applicants propose, through December 31, 1996, to redeem all of the shares of certain series of their preferred stock. (Rel. 35-26015)

PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Public Service Company of Oklahoma, an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to invest up to \$2.5 million, through capital stock purchases, in Excel Energy Technologies, Limited, which is engaged in research, development, and installation of proprietary energy management micro-processors. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-94-04) and Amendment Nos. 1 and 2 of the proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange, amending the net capital requirements in PHLX Rule 703. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 4. (Rel. 34-33838)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-94-2) to adopt a new Rule 123A.46 to ensure that customers are informed of the circumstances under which their orders are being represented. The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-92-41) relating to priority of agency orders to cross blocks of 25,000 shares or more. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 4. (Rel. 34-33835)
