NFCRCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

LEXANDER STEIN

An Administrative Law Judge has barred Alexander V. Stein from association with any investment adviser pursuant to Sections 203 (e) and (f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. Mr. Stein is serving a 71-month sentence based on his conviction on May 20, 1993 of 35 counts of securities fraud, wire fraud, mail fraud, and money laundering. United States v. Alexander V. Stein, CR 92-150 (D. OR). Judge Brenda P. Murray found that Mr. Stein had been associated with an investment adviser, AVS Research, Inc., at the time he raised approximately \$7.5 million from investors in a Ponzi scheme, and that the public interest requires that he not be allowed to participate in the securities industry. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST VICTOR TEICHER, ROSS FRANKEL AND VICTOR TEICHER & CO., L.P.

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Exchange Act and Section 203(f) of the Advisers Act against Victor Teicher (Teicher); Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Exchange Act against Ross S. Frankel (Frankel); and Section 203(e) of the Advisers Act against Victor Teicher & Co., L.P. (Teicher & Co.).

The Order For Public Proceedings alleges, among other things, that Teicher, Frankel and Teicher & Co. traded in securities while in possession of material, nonpublic information that each of them knew, had reason to know, or were reckless in not knowing was conveyed to each of them in breach of a fiduciary duty or other duty of trust or confidence; the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York permanently enjoined Frankel, by consent, from future violations of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder (SEC v. Teicher, Frankel, et al., 91 Civ. 1634 (MP) May 18, 1994); and on April 6, 1990, in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, Teicher, Frankel and Teicher & Co. were criminally convicted based on facts virtually identical to those alleged in the administrative proceeding.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations are true and, if so, what remedial sanctions are appropriate. (Rel. 34-34236; IA-1420)

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDERS OBTAINED AGAINST CROSS FINANCIAL SERVICES, INC., OWEN FOX, CARROLL SIEMENS, BRUCE FRANKLIN, MICHAEL COLELLO AND DOUGLAS CROSS

On June 23, the Commission filed a complaint in the Central District Court of California alleging that Cross Financial Services, Inc. (CFS), Owen R. Fox (Fox), Carroll E. Siemens (Siemens), Bruce Franklin (Franklin) and Douglas S. Cross (Cross) violated the registration and antifraud provisions and that Michael J. Colello (Colello) violated the antifraud provisions. The complaint alleges that since approximately April 1993 CFS, Fox, Siemens, Franklin and Cross have sold \$21 million in CFS's unregistered securities to over 700 investors and have misrepresented that CFS would use the investor funds to make loans secured by accounts receivable and to purchase bank guarantees. The complaint alleges that the defendants have misappropriated and misused investor funds to pay themselves over \$12.9 million, to pay CFS's business expenses totalling \$480,000, to pay undisclosed sales commissions to CFS's sales consultants and to operate a Ponzi.

The Court temporarily restrained and enjoined the defendants from further violations, immediately froze their assets, ordered accountings and appointed a temporary receiver over CFS. The Commission also seeks preliminary and permanent injunctions, disgorgement with prejudgment interest thereon and civil penalties. [SEC v. Cross Financial Services, Inc., Owen R. Fox, Carroll E. Siemens, Bruce Franklin, Michael J. Colello and Douglas S. Cross, No. 94-4228TJH(Ex), C.D. Cal.] (LR-14135)

EMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ENTERED AGAINST NEW WAY GROUP AND JAKE PILCHER

The Commission announced that it has filed a civil action in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia against New Way Group based in Florida, and its owner and operator, Jake Pilcher, alleging violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws arising out of defendants' ongoing offer and sale of unregistered securities. The Commission's complaint alleges that defendants have been and are engaged in a fraudulent scheme to induce investors to "lend" funds to New Way Group and an unidentified offshore trust where such funds will purportedly be "pooled" and used to finance the purchase and sale of "prime bank securities" by an unidentified offshore bank. Investors are promised quaranteed short term returns of 25 to 1, with no disclosed risk or effort on their part. The Temporary Restraining Order freezes defendants' assets, enjoins them from further violations of the federal securities laws, requires an accounting and expedited discovery. The Court set a hearing for the Commission's application for preliminary injunctive relief for June 30, 1994. In its complaint, the Commission seeks among other things, permanent injunctive relief, disgorgement and civil monetary penalties. [SEC v. DLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 18 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, and its nonutility subsidiary company, CSW Energy, Inc. (Energy) and Energy's proposed nonutility subsidiary company, Energy Sub (Energy Sub), whereby Energy Will form Energy Sub by acquiring all of its 1,000 shares of authorized common stock for a subscription price of \$1.00 per share; CSW and Energy Will provide acquisition and development costs for Energy Sub in respective amounts of \$11 million and \$5 million through capital contributions, loans and/or open account advances; and Energy Sub will acquire an 85

megawatt generation facility located in Wharton County, Texas from Texasgulf, Inc., a nonassociate company, to develop as an Exempt Wholesale Generator, as defined in Section 32 of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. (Rel. 35-26070)

PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec), a public-utility subsidiary company of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, to organize a special purpose subsidiary as a limited partnership (Penelec Capital) which will issue and sell, through June 30, 1996, up to \$125 million of Monthly Income Preferred Stock (MIPS). Penelec may also organize a second special purpose subsidiary to be the general partner of Penelec Capital (Investment Sub) and will capitalize Investment Sub with a promissory note in a principal amount of up to \$13 million. Penelec Capital will apply the proceeds of the MIPS, together with the payment of up to \$35 million for its general partnership interests, to purchase Penelec's subordinated debentures. Finally, Penelec will make certain guarantees in connection with the MIPS. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the distribution rate of the MIPS and the underwriting fees and expenses associated with the MIPS, pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-26071)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Philadelphia Depository Trust Company</u> (SR-PHILADEP-93-02) to permanently approve the <u>PHILAMET Terminal Communication</u> System and the Voluntary Offer Instruction service and to approve use of the Defender security system. (Rel. 34-34250)

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the <u>International Securities Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-ISCC-94-2) that amends its linkage agreement with the Japan Securities Clearing Corporation. Publication of the order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 27. (Rel. 34-34251; International Series Rel. 677)

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
