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## NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

The subject matter of the August 9 open meeting will be:

Consideration of whether to adopt amendments to Item 401 of Regulation S-K, relating to the disclosure of certain legal proceedings information about directors, executive officers, promoters and control persons. The amendments would add commodities proceedings to the legal proceedings currently required to be disclosed with respect to directors and executive officers and require new registrants to disclose the same legal proceedings involving promoters and control persons that they must disclose with respect to directors and executive officers. 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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### JOHN E. LIGUMS CITED

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act against John E. Ligums of Weston, Massachusetts, the general partner of a registered broker-dealer (Registrant) based in Boston.

The Order alleges that Ligums wilfully aided and abetted violations by Registrant of Section 7(c) of the Exchange Act and Regulation T by arranging for the extension of credit on securities in violation of those provisions. Ligums, purportedly representing retail customers, purchased stock from an underwriter and then sold the stock into the market to another broker-dealer, instructing the underwriter to deliver the stock against payment. Delivery was made against remittance of sale proceeds, while the purported retail customers were never required to deposit funds into their accounts at Registrant. Ligums is alleged to have indirectly benefited by approximately \$255,000 in broker commissions generated by this trading.

The Commission has accepted an offer of settlement wherein, without admitting or denying the allegations, Ligums consented to findings that he wilfully aided and abetted the aforementioned violations. Ligums was ordered suspended from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company for 14 calendar days. (Rel. 34-21156)

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## **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

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### **COMPLAINT NAMES GREATER COLUMBIA BANCSHARES, INC.**

The Chicago Regional Office filed a complaint seeking injunctive relief on July 17 in the Western District of Wisconsin against Greater Columbia Bancshares, Inc., a Portage, Wisconsin bank holding company. The complaint alleges that the defendant violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in two exchange offers for the common stock of The First National Bank of Portage.

The complaint alleges that: Bancshares registered its common stock with the Commission to effect an exchange offer for Bank stock, which expired on May 4, unsuccessfully; during this offer, Bancshares, through officers and directors of Bancshares and the Bank (the principals), purchased Bank stock otherwise than under the terms of the exchange offer; Bancshares subsequently made a second exchange offer, initiated on June 12; during both the second exchange offer and a competing cash tender offer, Bancshares, through certain of the principals, purchased Bank stock for \$150 per share; and this contributed to the apparent defeat of a competing cash tender offer.

On July 18, Judge Barbara Crabb, Western District of Wisconsin, entered, by consent, a permanent injunction against Bancshares and an order requiring it to make a rescission offer. (SEC v. Greater Columbia Bancshares, Inc., WD WI, Civil No. 84 C 572 C). (LR-10475)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Pacific Securities Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSDTC-84-8) establishing a dividend reinvestment program through which PSDTC participants with positions in eligible securities could reinvest cash dividends and retain the resulting securities on deposit with PSDTC. The proposal would also establish fees that reflect the costs of providing this service. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of July 30. (Rel. 34-21183)

### EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A rule change filed by the Depository Trust Company has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. The rule change (SR-DTC-84-4) establishes a 15% surcharge on DTC's monthly billings to participants and pledgee banks effective July 1, 1984. (Rel. 34-21187)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by: The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-84-11) to amend the requirements of Rules G-12(f) and G-15(d) to exempt transactions in public housing authority project notes from automated confirmation and comparison requirements until January 1, 1985. (Rel. 34-21189); and The Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-84-15) to allow the introduction of new series of index options with as few as 16 days left to expiration. (Rel. 34-21190)

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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 27 to request a hearing on an application by Public Service Company of New Hampshire for a determination by the Commission that J. Henry Schroder Bank and Trust Company should not be deemed to have a conflicting interest within the meaning of Section 310(b) of the Trust Indenture Act, which would disqualify it from acting as successor trustee under certain indentures, as a result of acting under three qualified indentures. The three qualified indentures were dated as of October 1, 1982 governing \$75 million of 15-3/4% debentures, due 1988, February 1, 1983 governing \$100 million of 14-3/4% debentures, due 1991, and November 1, 1983 governing \$100 million of 15% debentures, due 2003, and one unqualified indenture dated August 15, 1981 governing \$30 million of 17% notes, due August 15, 1986. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
