ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PHILLIP KEITH AND CHURCH, CHILDS, COMMODORE & CAMBRIDGE CITED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Phillip Keith and Church, Childs, Commodore and Cambridge. The Commission simultaneously accepted Respondents' Offers of Settlement, wherein, without admitting or denying the allegations contained therein, they consented to the Commission's Order Instituting Proceedings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions.

The Commission's Order finds that Respondents wilfully violated Section 206 of the Advisers Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5. The Commission: barred Keith from association with any investment adviser, broker-dealer, investment company and municipal securities dealer; and revoked Church, Childs, Commodore & Cambridge's registration as an investment adviser. PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST MARVIN W. HEGAR, JR.

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Marvin W. Hegar, Jr. of Houston, Texas, a former registered principal with a registered broker-dealer. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Hegar's Offer of Settlement. Hegar consented to the order finding that he was convicted on four counts of an indictment which: (1) arose out of the conduct of the business of a broker-dealer; and (2) involved the fraudulent conversion of funds [State of Texas v. Marvin Walter Hegar, Cause No. 392727 Crim. 28 (Harris County) March 28, 1984]. Hegar also consented to an order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-21355)

EDWARD ALLAN HARSH CITED

Public administrative proceedings have been instituted against Edward Allan Harsh of Reno, Nevada. The Order for Proceedings alleges that between December 1979 and December 1982, Harsh was involved in the offer and sale of two forms of securities: (1) interests in research and development partnerships; and (2) investment contracts consisting of fractional undivided interests in cargo containers coupled with collateral management, maintenance and insurance arrangements. The investments were sold through FoodSource, Inc., a company based in the San Francisco area. The Order alleges that both offerings violated the registration and antifraud provisions. A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations are true, and, if so, what sanctions are appropriate, if any. (Rel. 34-21364)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

STEPHEN G. KARANZALIS ENJOINED

The New York Regional Office announced that on October 2 Judge Charles L. Brieant, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, issued findings of fact and conclusions of law and signed a final judgment by consent permanently enjoining Stephen G. Karanzalis from further violations of the antifraud and tender offer provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

Karanzalis is a former registered representative for three registered broker-dealers. The findings of fact state that from late 1982 to March 1984 Karanzalis engaged in a scheme to misappropriate and trade on confidential, material non-public information from the New York City law firm of Skadden Arps, Slate, Meagher and Flom. In addition, Karanzalis consented to an administrative bar and an order of disgorgement totalling \$36,039.32, representing personal profits and commissions from trades based on material non-public information misappropriated from Skadden Arps. (SEC v. Stephen G. Karanzalis, et al., 84 Civil 2070 [CLB] SDNY). (LR-10556)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

E.F. HUTTON & COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 30 to request a hearing on an application of E.F. Hutton & Company and Hutton Telephone Trust First Tax-Free Exchange Series and Subsequent Series (the Trust) to amend a Commission order dated February 24, 1984 (Rel. IC-13787) granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act. The prior order permitted E.F. Hutton to purchase certain securities from the Trust at a fixed price. Applicants seek to amend the prior order to change the price at which E.F. Hutton may purchase certain securities from the Trust. (Rel. IC-14182 - Oct. 5)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 1 to request a hearing on a proposal by Louisiana Power and Light Company, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to enter into installment sales agreements with St. Charles Parish, Louisiana, in connection with the financing of pollution control facilities at Waterford Steam Electric Generating Station through the issuance and sale by the County of up to \$105 million in pollution control revenue bonds. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
