#### BANKERS NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-85-34) which would require NASD members to maintain a record of aggregate "short" positions in NASDAQ securities in all customer and proprietary firm accounts and to report such information to the NASD on a monthly basis.
