ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

HENDERSON, INC. AND WILLIAM ORR HENDERSON-

Administrative Law Judge Ralph Hunter Tracy filed an initial decision revoking the registration of Henderson, Inc. and barring its sole owner, William Orr Henderson, from association with any investment adviser.

Judge Tracy found that Henderson, Inc. and Henderson wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 by persuading clients to liquidate their brokerage accounts and invest the proceeds in certificates of deposits (CDs). However, instead of purchasing the CDs, Henderson converted a total of at least \$420,000 from ten different clients in 24 separate transactions. In some instances Henderson made unauthorized withdrawals from clients' securities brokerage accounts by forging clients' signatures on the withdrawal requests.

Judge Tracy also found that Henderson had received a ten-year prison sentence and Henderson, Inc. had been placed on probation for seven years by the Arizona Superior Court; and that both Henderson and Henderson, Inc. had been permanently enjoined by a U.S. District Court from violating the antifraud provisions of the Exchange and Advisers Acts.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST JEROME N. KING

The Boston Regional Office announced that on December 18, 1985 U.S. District Judge for the District of Connecticut Ellen Bree Burns signed a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Jerome N. King. The Judgment enjoins King from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. King consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The February 19, 1985 complaint alleged, among other things, that King, a certified public accountant, and others prepared or caused to be prepared tax returns and K-1 notifications (reports made to limited partner investors and filed with the Internal Revenue Service) for the year 1983, which contained untrue statements of material facts and omitted to state material facts. The complaint further alleged that the 1983 K-1 notifications falsely overstated the net asset values of various limited partnerships.

On February 19, 1985, Judge Burns signed a Temporary Restraining Order restraining King and others. (SEC v. James L. Condron, et al., USDC CT 1985, Civil Action No. B-85-87-EBB). (LR-10968)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AFFILIATED FUND, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Affiliated Fund, Inc. and other investment companies managed by Lord Abbett & Co., et al. (Applicants) granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 13(a)(2), 18(f)(1), 22(f) and 22(g) of the Investment Company Act and to permit Applicants to adopt deferred fee agreements for certain of their directors. A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Istituto Bancario San Paolo di Torino, an Italian Public Law Bank, and San Paolo U.S. Financial Company, for an order exempting them from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES.

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a pubic company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
