CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

THE INTELEPLEX CORPORATION AND JOHN J. VOIGT ENJOINED

The Washington Regional Office announced that on January 23 Judge Stanley S. Brotman, U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey, entered a Final Judgment and Order permanently enjoining The Inteleplex Corporation and John J. Voigt from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The complaint alleges that Inteleplex sold to at least 140 investors unregistered common stock for proceeds in excess of \$6 million and misrepresented material facts and omitted to state material facts that: it had received "firm orders" that would generate over \$5 million in revenues; would register the unregistered common stock it sold to investors; and would keep in escrow investor funds received for unauthorized shares of common stock until such time as the shareholders increased the number of authorized shares. The complaint further alleges that Inteleplex and Voigt sold investors telephone equipment that either did not exist or that Inteleplex previously had sold, and promised investors the right to depreciate and take investment tax credits on such equipment.

The defendants consented to the permanent injunctions without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations. (SEC v. The Inteleplex Corporation and John J. Voigt, DNJ, Civil Action No. 86-310). (LR-10993)

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST WORLDMASTERS CORPORATION AND CHRISTOS NETELKOS

The Washington Regional Office announced that on January 27, after a hearing, District Court Judge Joseph Longobardi, District of Delaware, issued a Preliminary Injunction against Worldmasters Corporation and Christos Netelkos, also known as Frank W. Roland, both of Smyrna, Delaware, enjoining them from violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The defendants admitted the allegations of the Commission's complaint.

The complaint alleges that: (1) since September 11, 1985, the defendants offered and sold Worldmasters common stock and warrants following an S-18 Registration Statement filed with the Commission; (2) the Registration Statement is false and misleading and omits to state material facts concerning the business and the financial condition of Worldmasters; (3) the three purported principals of Worldmasters are nonexistent and that the names are aliases of Netelkos; (4) Netelkos has been previously enjoined from violations of the securities laws in three separate prior actions and has been criminally convicted for securities laws violations in two other actions; (4) and Netelkos was a fugitive from two previously issued arrest warrants in New York and New Jersey since September 1984.

The court also froze all the defendants' assets pending further order of the court. (SEC v. Worldmasters Corporation and Christos Netelkos, USDC DDE, Civil Action No. 86-22). (LR-10994)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM RUBIN AND JANET KARKI CONVICTED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on January 23, after approximately a six-week trial, a federal jury in St. Paul, Minnesota, returned guilty verdicts on 12 of 28 counts against William Mark Rubin, former Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Flight Transportation Corporation and on 11 of 24 counts against Janet Reggs Karki, its former Chief Financial Officer. The defendants were convicted of violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and making untrue statements of material fact and omitting to state material facts in a registration statement

filed with the Commission in Flight's 1982 securities offering. These misstatements concerned, among other things, Flight's business operations, income and assets. The counts carry maximum five year prison sentences. (U.S. v. William Mark Rubin, et al., USDC DMN, Criminal No. 3-85-27). (LR-10992)

COLUMBUS AND SOUTHERN OHIO ELECTRIC COMPANY

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rules filed under Rule 19b-4 by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange, Inc. and the Options Clearing Corporation (SR-Phlx-85-10 and SR-OCC-85-14) to allow Phlx to trade and OCC to issue, clear and settle options on the European Currency Unit. (Rel. 34-22853 and 34-22854)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-86-1) that modifies its Automated Customer Account Transfer (ACAT) System. The proposal permits NSCC to accept corrections to ACAT transfers rather than reject them where Transfer Initiation Requests contain errors in customer account numbers.

Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of February 3. (Rel. 34-22858)

GEORGIA-PACIFIC CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 27 to request a hearing on an application of Georgia-Pacific Corporation for a finding by the Commission that Chase Manhattan Bank N.A. should not be deemed to have a conflicting interest which would disqualify it from acting as trustee under (1) a qualified indenture dated March 1, 1983 of Georgia-Pacific relating to \$395 million of unsecured debt securities of various series; and (2) an indenture of the County of Otsego Industrial Development Agency dated December 1, 1982 relating to \$5 million of Industrial Development Revenue Bonds.
