ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

REGISTRATION OF SIGMUNDR SECURITIES CORPORATION REVOKED; GEORGE J. DAVIS BARRED

The Commission issued an order instituting public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Sigmundr Securities Corporation, a registered Bedford, Texas broker-dealer, and its president, George J. Davis. Simultaneously with the institution of the proceedings, the Commission accepted Offers of Settlement from Sigmundr and Davis in which they, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, except those pertaining to civil injunctions which they admitted, consented to findings of violations and the sanctions imposed.

On the basis of the Order for Proceedings and the Offers of Settlement, the Commission found that Sigmundr and Davis: (1) wilfully violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act in connection with their sale of fractional undivided oil and gas interests through use of a nationwide boiler room operation and by misrepresenting, among other things, the potential profits associated with such investments; and (2) had been enjoined by consent from engaging in the violations just described.

Based on the above findings and the Offers of Settlement, Sigmundr's registration as a broker-dealer was revoked and Davis was barred from association with any broker or dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-23003)

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

JAMES C. KENNEDY NAMED REGIONAL ADMINISTRATOR OF PHILADELPHIA REGIONAL OFFICE

Chairman Shad announced the appointment of James C. Kennedy as the Regional Administrator of the Commission's soon-to-be-established Philadelphia Regional Office. Kennedy joined the SEC in 1967 in its Washington Regional Office and has held positions of increasing responsibility since that time. He most recently served as Assistant Regional Administrator in charge of Enforcement for the Arlington Virginia Office of the Washington Region. Kennedy received his B.S. from the Washington College of Law of American University, Washington, DC, in 1967.

As previously announced, the Commission is consolidating its offices in Arlington and Philadelphia, effective as of the latter part of May 1986. Kennedy will become the first Regional Administrator for the reconfigured office in Philadelphia with jurisdiction for Maryland, Delaware, West Virginia, Virginia, Pennsylvania and the District of Columbia.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

RICHARD CHIPPERFIELD AND MPG, LTD. ORDERED TO DISGORGE \$1 MILLION

The Boston Regional Office announced that on March 3 Senior U.S. District Judge Raymond J. Pettine, District of Rhode Island, granted the Commission's Motion for Summary Judgment of Disgorgement against Richard F. Chipperfield and MPG, Ltd. The Motion sought judgment of disgorgement of \$1 million in favor of the investors who purchased securities of MPG, denominated as debentures, during 1978-1981.

Judge Pettine permanently enjoined Chipperfield and MPG, who consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations, on July 15, 1983 from further violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the securities laws. The Commission alleged that Chipperfield made use of investor funds for personal expenses and failed to account for any expenditures of investor funds. At the time the injunction was entered, the defendants were further ordered to provide an accounting of investor funds; that accounting led to the Commission's Motion for Disgorgement. (SEC v. SHEARSON LEHMAN SPECIAL PORTFOLIOS

An order has been issued on an application filed by Shearson Lehman Special Portfolios amending a prior order and exempting it from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 11(a), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 22c-1 and 22d-1 to: permit certain exchange offers; modify the waiver of a contingent deferred sales charge respecting Shearson's automatic cash withdrawal plan; and modify the representations contained in the prior order respecting the terms of Shearson's distribution fee. MORTGAGE BANKERS FINANCIAL CORPORATION I
