INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

IDS CERTIFICATE COMPANY, INC.

An order has been issued exempting IDS Certificate Company, Inc. from certain provisions of Sections 28(a) and 28(i) of the Investment Company Act in order to permit it to use an alternative method of calculating its reserves. (Rel. IC-15045 - April 7)

MACKAY-SHIELDS MAINSTAY SERIES FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by MacKay-Shields MainStay Series Fund, MacKay-Shields MainStay Tax Free Bond Fund and New York Life Securities Corp. for an order permitting monthly distribution of long-term capital gains and permitting certain affiliated transactions involving investment company shares. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until April 28 to request a hearing on proposals filed by the following companies under the same release: Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L) - subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, and its subsidiary, Energy Initiatives, Inc. (EII), to recapitalize EII by capital contributions from JCP&L or the issuance and sale of EII's common stock to JCP&L which together will not exceed \$5 million. Additionally, EII seeks authority to borrow up to \$4 million, secured and unsecured; Western Massachusetts Electric Company - subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell \$25 million of first mortgage bonds under a new dividend restriction; Kentucky Power Company - subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to issue and sell up to \$50 million of unsecured, fixed-rate notes maturing in two to ten years to banks or other financial institutions; Monongahela Power Company, The Potomac Edison Company, and West Penn Power Company - subsidiaries of Allegheny Power Company, to repurchase or redeem preferred stock; Central Power and Light Company - subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to issue and sell \$200 million of first mortgage bonds and to acquire, under a tender offer, a substantial portion of a \$100 million series of its first mortgage bonds. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-86-1) that will allow participants to use its Voluntary Offering Program services to process acceptances of invitations to tender securities. Under the proposal, participants will have the option to accept eligible invitations either through DTC or directly with the tender agent and can surrender securities to the tender agent by book-entry movements from their accounts at DTC to the tender agent's account at DTC. NOTICE AND REQUEST FOR ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-86-5) to permit OCC margin credits from equity options to offset, in part, margin requirements for non-equity option (NEO) positions and for margin credits on NEO positions to partially offset margin requirements on equity positions. OCC requested that the Commission approve the proposed rule filing on an accelerated basis at the same time it approves File No. SR-OCC-85-21 (revision of OCC's NEO margin system). (Rel. 34-23107)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
