## TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN LASER ARMS CORPORATION

The Commission announced the temporary suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Laser Arms Corporation, a Delaware corporation located in New York, New York, for the ten-day period beginning at 9:30 a.m. (EST) on April 21 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on April 30.

The Commission suspended trading in the securities of Laser Arms because of an apparent lack of current, adequate and accurate public information concerning the company's business, operations, financial condition and products and the identity of current management.

# **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST HOLLIS B. REED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on March 27 a complaint was filed in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, seeking a permanent injunction against Hollis B. Reed. The complaint alleges that Reed violated and aided and abetted violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The complaint charges that from about January 1982 through July 1983, Reed raised \$3.3 million from approximately 178 investors through the sale of unregistered securities in the form of fractional undivided interests in nine oil and gas wells. The complaint also alleges that Reed made material misrepresentations and omissions concerning, among other things, the return on the investment, the risks associated with the investment, the expenses associated with drilling the wells, the compensation received by Reed, and the use of proceeds. Additionally, the complaint alleges that Reed acted as an unregistered broker. (SEC v. Hollis B. Reed, Civil Action No. C2-86-0338, filed March 27, 1986). (LR-11063)

The Denver Regional Office filed a complaint on April 9 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Utah naming Nordic Ltd., Inc. and David E. Ross, both of Salt Lake City, Utah.

The complaint alleges that Nordic and Ross violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The complaint further alleges that Nordic, aided and abetted by Ross, violated the reporting and proxy statement provisions of the Exchange Act. Ross is also charged with violating the beneficial ownership reporting provisions of the Exchange Act. The complaint alleges, among other things, that Nordic and Ross made misstatement regarding Nordic's purported acquisition of assets from Pan American International, including failing to disclose that Pan American had an absolute right to rescind the transaction. The complaint seeks a permanent injunction prohibiting the alleged violations in the future. (SEC v. Nordic Ltd., Inc. and David E. Ross, Civil Action No. 86-C-0291W). (LR-11064)

## **CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS**

### OTC NET PRINCIPALS PLEAD GUILTY

Robert N. Miller, U.S. Attorney for the District of Colorado, and the Denver Regional Office announced that on April 3 Juan Carlos Schidlowski, Joseph V. Pignatiello and Arlan I. Preblud entered guilty pleas before Judge Richard Matsch, U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado. Schidlowski and Pignatiello pleaded guilty to one count each of conspiracy and of failure to file an income tax return for 1981. Preblud pleaded guilty to one count of securities fraud.

These charges stem from a March 1985 indictment charging conspiracy and securities fraud in connection with using proceeds from bank loans to secretly purchase stock from OTC Net, Inc. (a now defunct Denver, Colorado broker-dealer firm) underwritings via a related Swiss brokerage firm, Otecenet S.A. The stock was then sold to the public at an inflated price. Schidlowski and Pignatiello were former founders and principals of OTC Net. Preblud was the president of Otecenet. Sentencing will occur at a future date. (U.S. v. Joseph V. Pignatiello, et al., USDC CO, Criminal Action No. 85-CR-106 and 85-CR-107). (LR-11061)

# **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

### NATIONWIDE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued granting Nationwide Life Insurance Company and Nationwide VLI Separate Account exemptions from Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2), 27(a)(1) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act and paragraphs (b)(1), (b)(13)(i)(B), and (c)(4)(ii) of Rule 6e-3(T). The exemptions will permit Nationwide and the Separate Account to use, for purposes of sales load computation, the 1958 Commissioner's Standard Ordinary Mortality Table, and to allow them to deduct an income tax charge if such taxes are incurred as a result of the operations of the Separate Account.
