U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

AMERICAN SPORTS ADVISORS, INC. ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on June 23 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against American Sports Advisors, Inc. of Garden City, New Jersey. The Judgment restrained and enjoined American from failing to file timely periodic reports and Notifications of Late Filing.

In its April 3 complaint, the Commission alleged that American, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended October 27, 1985 and its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarter ended February 3, 1986. The complaint further alleged that in connection with the failure to file these periodic reports, American failed to file required Notifications of Late Filing on Form 12b-25. American, consenting to the Court's Judgment, admitted that it had filed late three Annual and 12 Quarterly Reports and failed to file 15 Notifications of Late Filing. (SEC v. American Sports Advisors, Inc., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 86-0901). (LR-11142)
