CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

HARWYN INDUSTRIES, INC. NAMED IN COMPLAINT

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on September 23 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Harwyn Industries, Inc. of New York, New York. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief.

The Commission alleges that Harwyn, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended December 31, 1985, and its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarters ended March 31 and June 30, 1986, filed late Annual and Quarterly Reports, and failed to file a Notification of Late Filing. The Commission requests that the Court order Harwyn to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Harwyn Industries, Inc., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 86-6258). (LR-11238)

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST HOWARD A. LEVINE AND FRONTIER ENTERPRISES

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on September 23 Judge John F. Grady, Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, entered Final Judgments and Orders Permanent Injunction against Howard A. Levine and Frontier Enterprises. The Orders enjoin Levine and Frontier from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Order against Levine, entered following Levine's consent, provides that he disgorge monies he received directly or indirectly from the offer, purchase or sale of securities issued by Levine, Frontier and others.

The complaint and an accompanying Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order, filed on May 27, allege that from about July 1985 to about May 1986, Levine, Frontier, and others offered and sold unregistered securities in the form of partnership interests in oil and gas wells to approximately 600 investors nationwide, thereby raising about \$4.5 million. The complaint further alleges that the defendants made material misrepresentations and omissions to investors concerning, among other things, returns to be expected, risks associated with the investment, and existence of escrow accounts. (SEC v. Alvin R. Broerman, et al., Civil Action No. 86 C 3725, NDIL, filed May 27, 1986). (LR-11241)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

Supplemental orders have been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to: finance pollution control facilities in an amount up to \$10.4 million. Jurisdiction has been reserved over additional financing of up to \$83.2 million; and finance certain pollution control facilities located in various counties in the state of Georgia in the aggregate principal amount of not more than \$46 million. (Rel. 35-24208; 35-24209 - Oct. 7)

MONONGAHELA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Monongahela Power Company, subsidiary of Allegheny Power System, Inc., to increase the amount of its short-term notes issued to banks and to a commercial paper dealer through December 31, 1986 from a maximum principal amount outstanding at any one time of \$60 million to \$75 million. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-86-25) that would impose a \$500 processing fee payable by new applicants for regular, options principal and associate memberships, trading permit privileges and approval as authorized representatives. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of October 13. (Rel. 34-23684)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-86-31) to permit use of the General Securities Representative (Series 7) Examination and its study outline to qualify persons seeking registration as general securities representatives.
