ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

THOMAS W. BUCKINGHAM CENSURED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Thomas W. Buckingham, chief executive officer, president, and a trustee of California Tax-Free Money Fund (Tax Free), a registered investment company. The Order for Proceedings alleges that Tax Free contracted to purchase a \$1 million United States Treasury Bill from a broker-dealer at a time when Buckingham knew that Tax Free had insufficient assets to pay for the obligation. The contract to purchase excessively leveraged the fund and constituted a borrowing in violation of Tax Free's fundamental policies. In addition, the Order alleges that Buckingham failed to ensure that Tax Free segregated sufficient liquid assets to pay for the security.

Simultaneous with the institution of proceedings, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement from Buckingham in which he, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Order, consented to findings and a censure. (Rel. IC-15342)

CORRECTION RE NEW 1940 ACT APPLICATION FORMAT

The new standard format for publishing Notices of Filing of Applications for Exemptions applies to both the Investment Company Act and the Investment Advisers Act. The summary in the October 27th Issue of the Digest only included reference to filing under the Advisers Act.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

G. L. "DOC" ANDERSON ENJOINED

The Denver Regional Office announced that on October 16 Judge Richard P. Matsch, U.S. Court for the District of Colorado, entered an Order by consent permanently enjoining G. L. "Doc" Anderson, G. L. "Doc" Anderson, doing business as Petro Energy Dynamics, and G. L. "Doc" Anderson, doing business as Anderson PetroCorp, from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The matter is still pending against Jack R. Cohen, also known as Jack Cole, another named defendant.

The July 15 complaint alleged that, in the offer and sale of unregistered securities in the form of limited partnership interests in oil wells, the defendants made misrepresentations of material facts and omitted to state material facts concerning, among other things, the amount of compensation received by Petro Energy Dynamics and others; the actual cost to drill, test, and complete the oil wells; the production results of Petro Energy Dynamics' past experience with shallow oil and gas wells; and the financial condition of the related parties. Simultaneously, the Court accepted Anderson's consent to and ordered him to mail a copy of the Commission's litigation release to each investor who purchased any security issued or sold by Petro Energy Dynamics or Anderson PetroCorp. (SEC v. G. L. "Doc" Anderson, et al., Civil Action No. 86-M-1497 USDC CO). (LR-11272)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

RUSSELL A. PHIPPS SENTENCED

The U.S. Attorney for the Central District of California and the Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on October 17 U.S. District Court Judge J. Spencer Letts sentenced Russell A. Phipps to 12 years imprisonment and ordered him to make restitution of \$432,000 to his former brokerage firm clients. Phipps had previously pleaded guilty to charges of securities fraud, mail fraud, and interstate transportation of property taken by fraud. The indictment alleged that Phipps, while employed as a registered representative, had misappropriated at least \$440,000 from his clients. (U.S. v. Russell A. Phipps, No. CR 86-132-JSL, CDCA). INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BASCOM HILL BALANCED FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Bascom Hill Balanced Fund, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 22c-1 and 22d-1 to permit it to impose a contingent deferred sales load on certain redemptions of its shares and to permit a waiver or credit of the contingent deferred sales load with respect to certain redemptions. CONTINENTAL MUTUAL FUNDS TRUST

An order has been issued on an application filed by Continental Mutual Funds Trust, Continental Option Income Plus Fund II (together, Funds), Continental Equities Corporation of America, and CIC Asset Management Corporation, exempting the Funds from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act to allow the merger of the Funds, and permitting certain joint transactions between the Funds and affiliated persons incidental to the proposed merger. RYAN MORTGAGE ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION IV

An order has been issued exempting Ryan Mortgage Acceptance Corporation IV from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-15376 - Oct. 27)

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES; SOUTHERN ELECTRIC GENERATING COMPANY; WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY; KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until November 17 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies under the same release: Eastern Utilities Associates - a registered holding company, to acquire all of the capital stock of Citizens Heat and Power Corporation, which provides energy management services to institutional customers, and to engage in certain financing and related transactions; Southern Electric Generating Company - an indirect subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue notes to banks or other lenders from time to time on or prior to December 31, 1988, with maturities of up to five years, in a maximum aggregate principal amount at any one time outstanding of up to \$45 million; Western Massachusetts Electric Company - subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell, in one or more issues until December 31, 1987, up to 2,000,000 shares (\$50 million aggregate par value) of preferred stock with either a fixed or an adjustable dividend rate and to redeem up to 150,000 shares of its 16% preferred stock, Series C, \$100 par value; and Kentucky Power Company - subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, to issue up to \$35 million principal amount of unsecured, fixed-rate notes to banks or other financial institutions from time to time under a fixed-rate term-loan agreement. ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-86-19) to extend the effectiveness of its Rule 103A specialist evaluation pilot to March 31, 1987. (Rel. 34-23747)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-86-29) that would amend Article III, Section 28, of its Rules of Fair Practice to impose disclosure requirements on NASD members' associated persons who maintain securities accounts with non-NASD members such as investment advisers, banks, and other financial institutions. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of October 27. (Rel. 34-23754)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
