ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

M.S. WIEN & CO., INC., OTHERS CITED

The Commission has ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970 (SIPA) against M.S. Wien & Co., Inc. (Registrant), a registered broker-dealer and its principals, Stephen S. Wien and Daniel B. Engel. Registrant, with principal offices in New Jersey, is presently in the process of being liquidated pursuant to Section 5(b)(3) of the SIPA.

The Order for Proceedings alleges that registrant, Wien and Engel wilfully violated and wilfully aided and abetted violations of the customer protection, bookkeeping, margin, financial reporting, and supplemental reporting provisions of the Exchange Act.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against respondents are true, and if so, to decide what, if any, remedial action would be appropriate. (Rel. 34-18546)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DONALD L. COLVIN

MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has approved the following proposed rule changes: National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. - (SR-NASD-82-1) which amends the buy-in provisions of Section 59 of the NASD's Uniform Practice Code (UPC) by (i) removing the requirement that the selling member's trade comparison (or other document describing the trade) be attached to notices of intent to buy-in; (ii) eliminating the requirement that buy-ins be executed for "cash" or "guaranteed" delivery of certificates, and (iii) requiring a member that executes a buy-in to be prepared to defend the price at which the buy-in is executed relative to the current market price at the time of the buy-in. (Rel. 34-18562); and Pacific Clearing Corporation - (SR-PCC-79-1) establishing a participants' agreement. (Rel. 34-18563)
