ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

FINE IMPOSED ON MICHAEL NOVICK SUSTAINED

The Commission sustained sanctions imposed by the NASD on Michael H. Novick, formerly president and controlling stockholder of N.H. Novick & Co., Inc. The Commission had previously sustained the NASD's findings that Novick was responsible for unfair markups charged by his Firm in 51 retail sales of 2 securities. The Commission, however, had remanded the proceedings to the NASD for a further explanation of the Association's choice of sanctions.

On remand from the Commission, the NASD had affirmed its imposition of a censure, a fine of \$52,754.27, and a bar from association with any NASD member. On appeal from the remand, Novick challenged only the fine. The Commission found that Novick had failed to demonstrate a bona fide inability to pay and determined that the fine was neither excessive nor oppressive. (Rel. 34-37503)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE LAZARD FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 26 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Lazard Funds, Inc., et al. for an order under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to permit certain investment companies to deposit their uninvested cash balances in a single joint account to be used to enter into short-term investments. THE PILOT FUNDS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 26 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Pilot Funds, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) for an exemption from Sections 12(d)(1)(A) and 12(d)(1)(B), under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) for an exemption from Section 17(a), and under Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 thereunder permitting certain joint transactions. The order would permit certain investment companies to purchase shares of affiliated

money market funds in excess of the limits prescribed in Section 12(d)(1). (Rel. IC-22111 - July 30)

INSTITUTIONAL SERIES TRUST

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Institutional Series Trust has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22112 - July 31)

SAMUEL EVANS WYLY, ET AL.

A temporary order has been issued under Section 9(c) of the Investment Company Act on an application filed by Samuel Evans Wyly (Wyly) and Maverick Capital, Ltd. (Maverick). The order exempts Wyly and Maverick for a period of one year from the disqualification provisions of Section 9(a) of the Act with respect to a securities-related injunction entered against Wyly. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Central Power and Light Company, Public Service Company of Oklahoma and West Texas Utilities Company (collectively, Applicants), each a subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company. Applicants propose, through December 31, 1999, to: incur obligations in connection with the issuance of up to \$113.3 million aggregate principal amount of pollution control revenue bonds (New Bonds) in one or more series; obtain credit enhancement for the New Bonds, which could include bond insurance, a letter of credit or a liquidity facility; issue first mortgage bonds as security for the payment of the New Bonds; deviate from the Commission's Statement of Policy Regarding First Mortgage Bonds; and, use hedging products to manage interest rate risk or lower their interest rate costs. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-96-30) that would implement its short sale rule on a permanent basis. The NASD's short sale rule currently is on a pilot program that expires on August 3, 1996. The NASD also proposed a three-month extension of the pilot program for the short sale rule, which extension was approved on an accelerated basis by the Commission. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 5. (Rel. 34-37492)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-96-16) to amend NYSE Rules 13 and 123A.30 with regard to percentage orders. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 5. (Rel. 34-37495)

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-96-46) to amend Interpretation .01(d) under CBOE Rule 17.8 to allow Exchange staff thirty days to respond to a Respondent's document request before tolling the Respondent's settlement period. (Rel. 34-37496)

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-96-20) to reduce the Exchange's odd-lot equity transaction charges and its specialist odd-lot charge retroactively from January 1, 1996. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 5. (Rel. 34-37499)

ACCELERATED TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-96-22) filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers to extend certain rules of The Nasdaq Stock Market, Inc.'s Small Order Execution System (SOES) until January 31, 1997. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 5. (Rel. 34-37502)

DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration Encore Marketing International, Inc., Common Stock, \$0.01 Par Value and its 4% Series A Convertible Preferred Stock, Par Value \$10. (Rel. 34-37501)
