ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENT AND ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ENTERED AGAINST LARRY EARP AND FINAL JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST TRANS-AMERICAN OSTRICH TRADERS, INC. IN OSTRICH PARTNERSHIP CASE

The Commission announced that the Honorable Robert M. Takasugi of the United States District Court for the Central District of California entered final judgments against Larry R. Earp and Trans-American Ostrich Traders, Inc. on August 27 and August 22, respectively. The final judgment as to Earp was entered pursuant to his consent, while the final judgment as to Trans-American was entered upon the Commission's motion for default judgment. The action continues against defendant David P. Silver.

In its complaint, the Commission alleged that the defendants had violated Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint also alleged that Earp and Silver violated Section 15(a) of the Exchange Act.

The final judgments entered against Earp and Trans-American contain all of the permanent injunctive relief requested in the complaint. Furthermore, the final judgment as to Earp bars Earp from acting as an officer or director of any public company. Finally, the final judgment as to Trans-American requires it to pay \$7,170,000 in disgorgement, \$863,342.58 in pre-judgment interest thereon, and a civil penalty of \$7,170,000.

The Commission today also announced the issuance of an order barring Earp, by consent, from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser, or investment company. The Commission's order is based upon the entry of the injunction described above. [SEC v. Trans-American Ostrich Traders, Inc., Larry R. Earp, and David P. STEPHEN PARKER RECEIVES BAR WITH RIGHT TO REAPPLY AFTER ONE YEAR

The Commission today announced the institution of public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Stephen R. Parker (Parker), formerly a registered representative of Kinlaw Securities Corporation (Kinlaw Securities), a now defunct broker-dealer firm. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Parker's Offer of Settlement. The Commission found that on August 28, 1996, Parker, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's First Amended Complaint, consented to the entry of a permanent injunction. The First Amended Complaint, in SEC v. Kinlaw Securities Corporation, et al., alleged that the defendants, including Parker, engaged in the offer, purchase and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts involving interests in oil and gas drilling ventures in violation of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The First Amended Complaint further alleged that in connection with the offer, purchase and sale of these securities, the defendants made material misrepresentations and omissions of material fact concerning, among other things, the risks and expected returns associated with the oil and gas investments, the costs to drill and complete oil and gas wells, and the success of prior oil and gas wells.

The Order provides that Parker be barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company; provided, however, that he may reapply to become so associated after one year from the date of this Order. (Rel. 34-37664)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-96-26) relating to changes to NASD Rule 6630, formerly Section 2 of Part VI of Schedule D to the NASD By-Laws, to require NASD members registered with The Nasdaq Stock Market, Inc. (Nasdaq) as Consolidated Quotation Service (CQS) market makers to have available in close proximity to the Nasdaq terminals at which they make markets in CQS securities a quotation service that disseminates the bid prices and offer prices then being furnished by or on behalf of all exchanges and CQS market makers in the CQS issues for which they are registered. Publication of the notice of the proposed rule change in the Federal Register is expected during the week of September 16. (Rel. 34-37663)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange to change the method for determining the exercise settlement value of Nasdaq-100 options. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 16. (Rel. 34-37659)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Stock Exchange to renumber its rule concerning investment company units (SR-CHX-96-25) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 16. (Rel. 34-37657)
