## ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

---

### ORDER MAKING FINDINGS AND IMPOSING REMEDIAL SANCTIONS AGAINST GREENWAY CAPITAL CORPORATION AND JOSEPH GUCCIONE

The Commission announced that it entered an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) in connection with previously instituted public administrative and cease-and-desist proceedings against Greenway Capital Corporation (Greenway), a registered broker-dealer, and Joseph M. Guccione (Guccione), Greenway's former president. Greenway is headquartered in New York, New York, and has branch offices in Florida and Arizona. The Order makes findings that from about May 1994 through January 1995, Greenway willfully violated, and Guccione caused violations of, Section 15(g) of the Exchange Act and Rules 15g-2 through 15g-6 and 15g-9 thereunder (penny stock disclosure rules), in connection with the sale of shares of common stock of IDC Holdings, Ltd. (IDCH), a penny stock as defined by Section 3(a)(51)(A) of the Exchange Act.

The Commission ordered Greenway and Guccione to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations and future violations of the penny stock disclosure rules; censured Greenway; ordered Greenway to pay disgorgement of \$115,258, and pre-judgment interest of \$14,742; ordered Greenway to pay a civil money penalty of \$50,000; and ordered Greenway to comply with certain undertakings, including the hiring of an Independent Consultant, to review and where appropriate establish and implement effective, or improve existing, written internal procedures to ensure future compliance with the penny stock disclosure rules. Greenway and Guccione consented to the Order without admitting or denying any violations of the federal securities laws. (Rel. 34-37804)

#### SEC INSTITUTES 22 PROCEEDINGS AGAINST 29 INDIVIDUALS FOR PAYING KICKBACKS TO PROMOTE STOCKS

After an investigation in cooperation with the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the National Association of Securities Dealers, the Commission instituted 22 cease-and-desist and/or public administrative proceedings against 29 stock promoters. The Orders instituting these proceedings allege that the promoters paid, or arranged for the payment of, kickbacks to individuals who were, or whom they believed to be, registered representatives to induce them to purchase the common stock of various issuers for the accounts of customers.

The individuals named in the Commission's Orders are: Roland Acevedo, Steven W. Bingaman, Ira James Blackey, Richard Cedrone, John Chapman, Alan Wolfson, Cary F. Cimino, Theodore Heitzman, Richard Langley, Jr., Gerald Larder, Michael Lapp, William Lucas, Norman Lescht, Miron Leshem, Richard Mallion, Gamal Marwan, Robert Mitchell, Gary Mitchell, Edward S. Padnos, Jeffrey D. Pokross, Alexander Ruge, Robert Schulman, Al Avasso, Andrew Scudiero, Sy Siegel, Bertram Slutsky, Jeff Szur, Jeffrey Trenk and Ed Williamson.

Hearings will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against the 29 respondents are true, and, if so, what remedial actions, if any, are appropriate and in the public interest, whether cease-and-desist orders should issue against them, whether disgorgement should be imposed, whether the registered representatives should be otherwise sanctioned, and whether certain respondents should be barred from promoting penny stocks. #### PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Public Service Company of Oklahoma, an electric public utility

subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to increase its investment in Excel Technologies, Ltd. to \$2,718,764.91, from \$2.35 million, and to consummate certain related purchases and exchanges of securities issued by Excel. (Rel. 35-26588)

#### NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

An order has been issued authorizing New England Electric System, a registered public-utility holding company, to issue and sell short-term notes to banks from time to time, through October 31, 2001, in outstanding principal amounts of up to \$100 million. (Rel. 35-26589)

#### ALLEGHENY POWER SYSTEM, INC., ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Allegheny Power System, Inc. (APS), a registered holding company, AYP Capital, Inc. (AYP), a nonutility subsidiary company of APS, and Allegheny Power Service Corporation, for APS and AYP to increase a limit on loans and guarantees, from APS and AYP to AYP and special-purpose subsidiary companies, from \$100 million to \$300 million. This increase was requested, in part, because AYP has agreed to purchase the 50% interest of Duquesne Light Company in Fort Martin Generating Station Unit No. 1, an exempt wholesale generator, for \$181 million. (Rel. 35-26590)

#### GPU, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing GPU, Inc. (GPU) to issue and sell for cash, through December 31, 1998, up to 7 million shares of its authorized but unissued common stock (Additional Shares). The order authorizes GPU to apply the net proceeds from the sale of the Additional Shares to make cash capital contributions to its electric and other operating subsidiaries, to repay or refinance outstanding indebtedness, and for general corporate purposes, including the acquisition, through subsidiaries, of interests in qualifying facilities, exempt wholesale generators and foreign utility companies.
