COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

COMMISSION PROVIDES WRITTEN GUIDANCE ON IMPLEMENTATION OF RULE 11Ac1-6

On June 22, the Commission announced that the Division of Market Regulation has published Staff Legal Bulletin No. 13 responding to questions the staff has received from market participants on the implementation of Rule 11Ac1-6. Rule 11Ac1-6 requires all broker-dealers that route orders in equity and option securities to make available quarterly reports that present a general overview of their routing practices. The legal bulletin, in the form of a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) document, sets forth the views of the Division of Market Regulation. The Commission has neither approved nor disapproved its content.

COMMISSION ISSUES ONE-MONTH EXEMPTION FROM PUBLIC REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF ORDER EXECUTION QUALITY DISCLOSURE RULE FOR LISTED SECURITIES; PROVIDES ADDITIONAL WRITTEN GUIDANCE ON IMPLEMENTATION OF RULE

On June 22, the Commission announced that it has issued a one-month exemption with respect to any market center that is required to prepare a report under Rule 11Ac1-5 that covers trading in May 2001. Under the exemption, such a market center is not required to make its May report publicly available on an Internet site; the market center, however, must prepare a May report internally and make it available for inspection and examination by the Commission staff. The Commission emphasized that reports that cover trading in June must be made publicly available on an Internet site by the end of July. The exemption is set forth in a letter to the New York Stock Exchange, Inc.

The Division of Market Regulation also has published an updated Staff Legal Bulletin No. 12R responding to questions the staff has received from market participants on the application of Rule 11Ac1-5. The legal bulletin, in the form of a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) document, sets forth the views of the Division of Market Regulation. The Commission has neither approved nor disapproved its content.

Among the matters addressed in the legal bulletin, the Commission has exempted from Rule 11Ac1-5 orders in national market system securities that are very inactively traded and certain small market centers that do not focus their business on the most actively traded securities. The small firm exemption covers any market center that reported fewer than 200 transactions per trading day on average over the preceding six month period in securities that are covered by the Rule, but only if more than 90% of such transactions were in securities that are not included in the Nasdaq-100 Index or the S&P 500 Composite Stock Price Index. The exemptions are set forth in a letter to the NASD Small Firms Advisory Board.

Finally, the legal bulletin provides guidance on a number of other issues that is intended to enhance the reliability and comparability of the order execution quality statistics to be disclosed under the Rule.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IN THE MATTER OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA

Chief Judge Brenda P. Murray has found that the City of Miami, Florida, violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Exchange Act Rule 10b-5 by providing materially false information and omitting material information about the City's financial status in the Official Statements for three municipal bond offerings in June, July, and August 1995 and in the City's widely distributed 1994 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report. Chief Judge Murray faulted Miami for certifying that there had been no material changes in its financial situation since the date of the 1994 audit report, when the City was coping with a cash crisis situation all of 1995. She found the City's disclosure contained false and misleading representations concerning a reduction in force initiative and its fiscal 1995 budget, and failed to reveal that Standard & Poor's reduced the rating on the City's general obligation debt after the close of fiscal 1994. Chief Judge Murray rejected the City's position that it was not culpable because its auditor and investment professionals approved the City's disclosures.

Considering the nature of the violations and the City's attitude on its responsibilities as an issuer of securities, Chief Judge Murray ordered the City to cease and desist. (Initial Decision No. 185; File No. 3-10022)

AMERICAN CLASSIC VOYAGES CRUISE LINE CONSENTS TO CEASE AND DESIST ORDER FOR FILING INACCURATE AND MISLEADING QUARTERLY RESULTS

The SEC announced today that it entered an Order Instituting Proceedings Pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Making Findings and Imposing a Cease-and-Desist Order against American Classic Voyages Co., headquartered in Chicago, for filing with the Commission an inaccurate and misleading quarterly report for first quarter of 1999. Without admitting or denying its findings, except as to the Commission's jurisdiction, American Classic consented to the entry of the Order, which orders the company to cease and desist from committing or causing violations of reporting provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The Order finds that, as a result of improperly capitalizing advertising costs, instead of expensing those costs as it did in previous quarters, American Classic filed a Form 10-Q for the first quarter of 1999 that was inaccurate and misleading in three respects. First, the Management's Discussion and Analysis (MD&A) section of the first quarter 1999 Form 10-Q compared operating results for the first quarters of 1999 and 1998 without disclosing that the capitalization of advertising costs substantially improved reported results for the first quarter of 1999. Second, the financial statements in the first quarter 1999 Form 10-Q understated American Classic's net loss for the period by 29%, and understated its selling, general and administrative expenses, because the capitalization and deferral to later quarters of certain advertising costs deviated from generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP). Third, American Classic deviated from GAAP by failing to disclose in its first quarter 1999 Form 10-Q that it had changed accounting treatment for its advertising costs. COMMISSION INSTITUTES ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING AGAINST VICTOR WILSON

On June 22, the Commission instituted a public administrative proceeding against Victor M. Wilson, pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act. Simultaneously with the institution of this proceeding, Wilson submitted an Offer of Settlement, in which, while neither admitting nor denying the Commission's findings, Wilson agreed to the entry of an Order permanently barring him from association with any investment adviser. The Order was based on the entry of a permanent injunction in a civil action against Wilson. The Commission's complaint alleged that Wilson violated Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder by, among other things, raising approximately \$1.2 million from hundreds of investors in the United States and Dominica from March 1997 through April 1998. The Commission alleged that Wilson falsely represented to investors that their money would be invested in a so-called "60-40 program" promoted by a bank

purportedly chartered in the non-existent "Dominion of Melchizedek," and that investors would receive astronomical returns with no risk of loss. (Rel. IA-1949; File No. 3-10522)
