## DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

SECURITY SAVINGS AND LOAN EXEMPTED FROM QUARTERLY REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The SEC has granted a limited exemption to Security Savings and Loan (A Stock Corporation), Baltimore, Md., which relieves it from the quarterly reporting requirements of Rule 13a-13 under Section 13(a) of the Securities Exchange Act, while denying the company's request for a broad exemption from the registration, reporting and proxy requirements of the Securities Exchange Act.

Security is a guaranty stock savings and loan institution with (1) free shares represented by the withdrawable savings accounts and (2) guaranty stock, which provides a secondary reserve for the payment of losses and, upon liquidation, is entitled to the undivided profits and reserves after required payments to the free shareholders. Between March 1968 and September 1969 Security merged with three mutual associations which had only free shares, which were exchanged for equal free shares in Security and, as required by Maryland regulatory authorities, guaranty stock was also issued by Security to such free shareholders. As a result of such mergers 1,360 persons received 46,603 guaranty shares in Security, which prior to that time had only 85 guaranty stockholders. In granting the exemption from filing quarterly reports, the Commission considered among other factors, the absence of a regular market for the guaranty stock, the relatively small number of transactions effected in it, the origin and nature of a substantial portion of the public investor interest, Security's limited income, and the state regulation to which it is subject. The Commission noted that applicant will still be subject to other Commission requirements respecting the filing of annual reports and current reports of specified events and to its proxy rules and regulations. JOHN G. MONTANA AND DANIEL J. CLARIDY SUSPENDED. The SEC has issued an order suspending John Gary Montana and Daniel John Claridy, former president and vice-president, respectively, of Barclay Securities, Inc. of New York, a registered broker-dealer now in bankruptcy, from association with any broker-dealer for 5 days effective August 30, 1971.

According to the Commission's decision, Montana and Claridy, during the period May-August 1970, aided and abetted violations of the net capital provisions of the securities laws. The Commission's order was issued pursuant to an offer of settlement in which respondents, without admitting or denying the allegations against them, consented to the indicated findings and sanctions. ## COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

SENTINEL AIRLINES, OTHERS ENJOINED. The SEC Fort Worth Regional Office announced August 18 that the Federal Court in Dallas had preliminarily enjoined Sentinel Airlines, Inc., James G. McCollom and Alexander Alexander, all of Dallas, and James W. Marchbanks of Fort Worth from violations of the registration and anti-fraud provisions of the Federal securities laws in the offer and sale of stock of Sentinel Airlines. The defendants consented to the order without admitting the allegations. (LR-5142)

COMPLAINT NAMES UNIVERSAL MINING, OTHERS. The SEC Fort Worth Regional Office announced August 18 the filing of a complaint in the Federal Court in Dallas seeking to enjoin violations of the Federal securities laws in the offer and sale of investment contracts evidenced by silver contracts and warehouse receipts for silver ore by Garland H. Lincecum, Jr., Universal Mining Corp., Francis W. Marshall and Majestic Sales of Texas, Inc., all of Dallas, Joseph J. Hirsh, East Orange, N.J., Morton E. Weiman, Philadelphia, and George M. Samuels and Transcontinental Industries, Inc., both of Miami, Fla. (LR-5143)

ALBERT N. DUKOW SENTENCED. The SEC Washington Regional Office today announced that the Federal Court in Pennsylvania has sentenced Albert N. Dukow of Pittsburgh in connection with violations of the antifraud provisions of the Federal securities laws in connection with the offer and sale of securities of Champion Ind., Inc. Dukow was convicted on eight counts and fined \$500 on each count for a total of \$4,000. On four counts, he was sentenced to 30 days imprisonment on each count, the sentences to run concurrently. On the other four counts, he received a 3-year suspended sentence on each count, the sentences to run concurrently. He is to be placed on probation for 3 years upon his release from 30-days imprisonment. (LR-5144)

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALEX. BROWN & SONS. The SEC has issued an order under the Investment Company Act upon application of Alex. Brown & Sons, Baltimore, Md. prospective co-representative with E.F. Hutton & Co., Inc., of a group of underwriters of a proposed public offering of shares of American General Bond Fund, Inc., a registered closed-end investment company, exempting certain transactions incident to the distribution of Bond Fund shares from certain provisions of the Act. OVER

ITTEX FUND. The SEC has issued an order under the Investment Company Act declaring that ITTEX Fund, New York, has ceased to be an investment company. (Release IC-6699)

#### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act giving interested persons until September 23 to request a hearing upon an application of National Fuel Gas Company, New York, and its two subsidiaries, Iroquois Gas Corp. and Producers Gas Company, both of Buffalo, N.Y., with respect to National's proposal to merge Producers into Iroquois. Such merger would involve the cancellation of the 48,000 outstanding capital shares (\$10 par) of Producers and the issuance of an additional 4,800 shares (\$100 par) of Iroquois to National. OHIO POWER. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act authorizing Ohio Power Company, Canton subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to increase from \$95,500,000 to \$129,500,000 the amount of short-term notes to banks and commercial paper dealers which may be outstanding at any one time and to issue and sell \$20,480,000 of such short-term notes to 53 banks. Net proceeds will be used in connection with the company's construction program and for other corporate purposes. (Release 35-17251)

GPU SERVICE CORP. The SEC has issued a notice under the Holding Company Act giving interested persons until September 17 to request a hearing upon an application of General Public Utilities Corp., New York, and its newly organized subsidiary GPU Service Corp. Service Corporation proposes to issue and sell up to \$8.8 million of unsecured promissory notes from time to time to not more than eight commercial banks in the Reading, Pennsylvania area. Net proceeds will be used to finance the construction and partially equip a building which it intends to erect near Reading Municipal Airport, to be used as its headquarters office. Construction of the building is estimated at some \$6.2 million. (Release 35-17249)

#### SECURITIES ACT REGISTRATIONS

OCEAN FISHERIES, INC., 1355 Harbor Dr., San Diego, Calif. 92102, filed a registration statement on August 25 seeking registration of 420,000 shares of common stock, of which 336,000 are to be offered for public sale by the company and 84,000 (being outstanding shares) by the holders thereof. The offering is to be made (\*at \$12 per share maximum) through underwriters headed by Mitchum, Jones and Templeton, Inc., 510 South Spring St., Los Angeles, Calif. 90013. The company owns and operates a large high seas tuna fleet. Of the net proceeds of its stock sale, \$600,000 will be applied to the partial repayment of the current portion of long term debt, the proceeds of which were used for the construction of a tuna vessel, and any balance for other corporate purposes. JAYMEE INDUSTRIES, INC., 229-245 Green St., Brooklyn, N.Y. 11222, filed a registration statement on August 25 seeking registration of 216,000 shares of common stock, to be offered for public sale at \$7.50 per share through S.J. Salmon & Co., Inc., 77 Water St., New York. The company is engaged in the dyeing and finishing of double knit polyester fabrics for use in the manufacture of wearing apparel. Of the net proceeds of its stock sale, \$450,000 will be used as partial payment for the purchase and installation of machinery in the company's knitting plant and the balance for other corporate purposes. TUCSON GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, 220 W. Sixth St., Tucson, Ariz. 85702, filed a registration statement on August 25 seeking registration of \$25 million of first mortgage bonds, due 2001, to be offered for public sale by the company and 634,854 outstanding shares of common stock by the holders thereof. The offering is to be made (\*at \$16.50 per share maximum) through underwriters headed by Blyth & Co., Inc., 14 Wall St., and The First Boston Corporation, 20 Exchange Place, both of New York, N. Y. 10005. Net proceeds of the company's bond sale will be used in connection with its continuing construction program, including repayment of \$18 million of short-term bank loans and \$5 million of commercial paper. Construction expenditures are estimated at \$45 million for 1971 and \$145 million for the period 1972 through 1975. (File 2-41563)

EVANS PRODUCTS COMPANY, 1121 S. W. Salmon St., Portland, Oregon 97208, filed a registration statement on August 25 seeking registration of 67,600 outstanding shares of common stock, which may be offered for sale from time to time by the holders thereof at prices current at the time of sale (\*\$40.625 per share maximum). COTTON PETROLEUM CORPORATION, Parkland Plaza Bldg., 2121 South Columbia, Tulsa, Okla. 74114, filed a registration statement on August 25 seeking registration of 1,070,000 shares of common stock. It is proposed to offer these shares in exchange for all the outstanding stock of Cotton Petroleum Company (CPC) and oil and gas properties originally acquired by participation in certain oil and gas drilling programs conducted by CPC, at the rate of one share of stock for each \$7 of exchange value.
