DECISION IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

NASD DISCIPLINE OF HAGEN INVESTMENTS AND EDWARD HAGEN UPHELD. The SEC has dismissed an application by Hagen Investments, Inc., of Oklahoma City, Okla., and Edward J. Hagen, its president, for review of disciplinary action by the NASD in which it fined them \$3,000 and censured them, suspended the firm's membership in the NASD for three days, and suspended Hagen from associating with any member for the same period. (During the pendency of the NASD proceedings, the Commission, in unrelated proceedings, revoked the firm's broker-dealer registration and barred Hagen from association with any broker or dealer.) The NASD found that during the period December 1968 - February 1969 applicants have failed to comply, in a large number of instances, with restrictions and requirements imposed by certain NASD emergency rules designed to deal with the large volume of "fails" carried in the accounts of broker-dealers during that period. Those rules prohibited a member from selling a security for its own account or buying a security for a customer if it had any fail to deliver in that security 120 days old or older and required fails to deliver or to receive to be cleared within 30 days after reaching 120 days in age.

The Commission rejected applicants' contention that the rules were not properly enacted under NASD by-law provisions permitted the Board of Governors to adopt emergency rules without submission to the membership. And it held that, with limited exceptions, the NASD was warranted in concluding that the transactions in question involved fails items. (Release 34-9325)

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT

CIGARETTE BREAKERS, INC. REG A EXEMPTION PERMANENTLY SUSPENDED. The Commission has issued an order permanently suspending the Regulation A exemption from registration with respect to a proposed public offering of securities by Cigarette Breakers, Inc. of Denver, Colo.

The order alleged that: The notification and offering circular contained omissions and untrue statements of material facts with respect to (1) the failure to disclose that the principal purpose of the incorporation of the issuer and the offering was to create a market for, and to manipulate the market for the benefit of the officers and directors, (2) the failure to disclose that after the offering, false rumors were to be spread driving the price of the stock down, while the officers and directors sold short, (3) the failure to disclose that the stock would be further manipulated by the purchase and sale of the stock by two mutual funds controlled by a director, (4) the failure to disclose that no genuine effort to further the business would be made, and (5) that Robert Ramm, the principal promoter is subject to a Canada-wide warrant for selling fraudulent stock.

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

COMMONWEALTH SECURITIES CORP. ENJOINED. The SEC Atlanta Regional Office announced September 2 that the Federal Court in Nashville, Tenn. had permanently enjoined Commonwealth Securities Corp., Nashville broker-dealer, and Jack E. Friedman, until recently its president, also of Nashville, from violations of the net capital, hypothecation and bookkeeping and certain of the antifraud provisions of the Federal securities laws. On August 26, Fred D. Bryan was appointed as receiver of Commonwealth. The defendants consented to the court order without admitting the allegations. (LR-5158)

INJUNCTION AGAINST ADVANCE GROWTH CAPITAL CORP. DENIED. The SEC announced September 1 that the Federal Court in Illinois had denied the Commission's request for injunctive relief against Advance Growth Capital Corp., Peter D. Giachini and John J. Murphy. The Commission's request that a receiver be appointed for Advance Growth was also denied. (LR-5159)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DISBRO EQUITY-LEASING CORP., The SEC has issued an order under the Investment Company Act declaring that Disbro Equity-Leasing Corp., Willoughby, Ohio, has ceased to be an investment company as defined in the Act. (Release IC-6719)

SHAREHOLDERS INVESTMENT PROGRAMS. The SEC has issued a notice under the Investment Company Act giving interested persons until September 28 to request a hearing upon an application of Shareholders Investment Programs for the Accumulation of Shares of Enterprise Fund, Inc., Los Angeles, Calif. unit investment trust, for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. A registration statement filed with the Commission has not been made effective and applicant has requested its withdrawal. Applicant represents that it has no assets or liabilities, that none of its securities have been issued or offered for sale, and that no offer or sale of securities is contemplated. 1/ (Release IC-6720)

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ANDES COPPER. The SEC has announced the withdrawal on August 6 of the applications of Andes Copper Mining, Chile Exploration Company and Chile Copper Company for orders declaring that each is not an investment company. On April 30, 1971, each company was granted an exemption from the provisions of Section 7 of the Act until such time as the Commission acted on the applications. The orders of temporary exemptions, accordingly, have ceased to be in effect. (Release IC-6721)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC. The SEC has issued a notice under the Holding Company Act giving interested persons until September 30 to request a hearing upon an application of Massachusetts Electric Company, Westborough, Mass. subsidiary of New England Electric System, to amend its by-laws to increase from 300,000 to 600,000 the number of shares of preferred stock which may be issued without a vote of preferred stockholders. Massachusetts Electric intends to submit the proposed amendment for stockholder approval at a special meeting to be held October 7, 1971 and to solicit proxies from holders of its outstanding preferred stock to be voted at the meeting. 1/ (Release 35-17257)

MICHIGAN CONSOLIDATED GAS. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act authorizing Michigan Consolidated Gas Company, Detroit subsidiary of American Natural Gas Company, to issue and sell up to \$30 million of unsecured promissory notes to banks. Net proceeds of its financing will be used to finance, in part, its 1971 construction program estimated at \$60 million. (Release 35-17258)

METROPOLITAN EDISON. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act authorizing Metropolitan Edison Company, Berks County, Pa. subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corp., among other things, to increase from \$44 million to \$50 million the amount of short-term notes to banks which it may have outstanding at any one time, to increase to 40 the number of banks which it may effect borrowings, and to extend to December 31, 1972 the date up to which it may be permitted to issue such notes. (Release 35-17259)

UNITED VIRGINIA BANK/STATE PLANTERS. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act declaring neither United Virginia Bank/State Planters, of Richmond, Va., nor The Planters National Bank and Trust Co. of Rocky Mount, N.C., will become an "electric utility company" within the meaning of the Act as a result of certain transactions involving the purchase and lease of combustion turbines and related equipment. (Release 35-17260)

DELMARVA POWER & LIGHT. The SEC has issued a notice under the Holding Company Act giving interested persons until September 30 to request a hearing upon an application of Delmarva Power & Light Company of Virginia, subsidiary of Delmarva Power & Light Company, to issue and sell to the parent up to \$1,450,000 of promissory notes, due 1973, and up to 14,500 shares of common stock (\$100 par) to the parent. Delmarva (Virginia) will use the net proceeds of its financing to provide funds for future construction expenditures. Proposed additions to property and plant are estimated at \$833,927 for 1971, \$2,201,866 for 1972 and \$1,753,600 for 1973. 1/ (Release 35-17262)

SECURITIES ACT REGISTRATIONS

FLORIDA POWER CORPORATION, 101 Fifth St., South, St. Petersburg, Fla. 33701, filed a registration statement on September 2 seeking registration of \$50 million of first mortgage bonds, due 2001, to be offered for public sale at competitive bidding. Net proceeds will be used to partially repay temporary borrowings incurred for construction purposes, which are expected to amount to \$55 million at the time of the issue of the bonds. Construction expenditures are estimated at \$168 million for 1971. (File 2-41661)

TEXECAN CORPORATION, 2446 North Shadeland Ave., Indianapolis, Ind. 46219, filed a registration statement on September 2 seeking registration of \$1,000,000 of 8% convertible subordinated debentures, due 1981, and 20,000 outstanding shares of common stock.
