SUBJECT: Report on the Federal Communication Commission's (FCC) Fiscal Year 2011 Federal Information Security Management Act (FISMA) Evaluation

In accordance with Federal Information Security Management Act (FISMA) the FCC Office of Inspector General (OIG) engaged the independent certified public accounting firm of KPMG LLP to evaluate the Commission's progress in complying with the requirements of FISMA. Specifically, this evaluation included assessing the Commission's efforts to develop, document, and implement an agency-wide program to provide information security for the information and information systems that support the operations and assets of the Commission, including those provided or managed by another agency, contractor, or other source.

The attached KPMG LLP report identifies 15 findings and offers 67 recommendations to address those findings. Most of the findings were comprised of multiple issues. Thirteen findings contained issues that were repeated from the FY 2010 FISMA evaluation. The remaining two findings contained entirely new issues. Management's response to the report is included as an attachment to KPMG's report. The OIG reviewed KPMG LLP's reports and related documentation and made necessary inquiries of KPMG's representatives. KPMG LLP is wholly responsible for the attached report and the conclusions expressed therein.
