Dear Rate Case Parties and Customers:

On March 21, 2002, Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) will hold the second of three rates-related workshops. The purpose of this series of workshops is to develop a Mark-to-Market methodology to be used in setting the Load-Based Cost Recovery Adjustment Clause (LB CRAC). This methodology will be used when determining the Load-Based Cost Recovery Adjustment Clause (LB CRAC) for future six-month cycles.

The second workshop will focus on reviewing and discussing the options proposed at the first meeting. Alternative or new options may also be discussed. If a consensus is reached, a methodology may be put into place for setting future LB CRACs.
