

ADDENDUM. LIST OF APPROVED FUEL SAFETY TRAINING COURSES

All courses listed in the addendum are acceptable to the Administrator and address the seven items listed in §139.321 (b). Comprehensive courses will include subject areas beyond those listed in §139.321 (e.g., fueling procedures for various types of aircraft; use of current or advanced fuel technologies and equipment, other airside products such as oils, deicing and hydraulic fluids, various lubricants). Fueling supervisors who plan to attend a *recurrent* Fueling Safety Training course must select one of the *asterisked* companies offering recurrent fuel safety training. These companies have comprehensive programs that offer preparation not only in the technical areas but also in techniques for delivering the safety-first message to the employees whom they supervise.
