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NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET NOV. 1-3 IN ROCKVILLE, MD.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) will hold a public meeting Nov. 1-3 in Rockville, Md., to discuss, among other items, topics of interest to NRC Commissioner Peter B. Lyons. In addition, the committee will be briefed on NRC staff's implementation of the lessons learned from the review of Early Site Permit (ESP) applications for nuclear power plants, the Vogtle ESP application, ESBWR reactor design certification safety evaluation, and an extended power uprate application for the Susquehanna nuclear power plant.

Portions of this meeting may be closed to protect information that is proprietary and are identified in the agenda.

The ACRS advises the Commission on licensing and operation of nuclear power plants and related safety issues.

The meeting will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building, at 11545 Rockville Pike.
