NRC NAMES NEW SENIOR RESIDENT INSPECTOR AT DIABLO CANYON POWER PLANT

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission has assigned Michael Peck as senior resident inspector at the Diablo Canyon nuclear plant, located near San Luis Obispo, Calif.

“Michael Peck’s extensive technical and regulatory experience will assist the NRC in carrying out its mission of protecting people and the environment and ensuring the safe operation of nuclear power plants,” said NRC Region IV Administrator Elmo E. Collins.

Peck holds a Ph.D in nuclear engineering from the University of Missouri. He has worked as an operations and reactor engineer with the Tennessee Valley Authority and for the Department of Energy at the Hanford Nuclear Reservation. Since joining the NRC Peck has served as a resident inspector at several plants and has been the senior resident inspector at the Callaway nuclear plant since 2002.

Each of the country’s commercial nuclear plants has resident inspectors who serve as the agency’s eyes and ears at the facility, conducting regular inspections, monitoring significant work projects and interacting with plant workers and the public.
