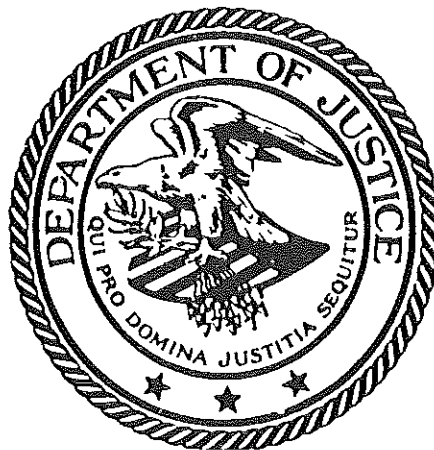



WORK HANDLED BY UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES
DURING FISCAL YEAR 1966

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - Criminal filings amounting to 32,633 showed a decrease of 1,034 or 3.0 per cent from the number filed in the previous fiscal year. About 79 per cent of the total was in 14 offenses having 500 or more cases; five showed increases while ten showed decreases. The largest increases occurred in Counterfeiting and Forgery (2,017 to 2,097), Selective Service (369 to 642), Bank Robbery (638 to 743). Income Tax dropped from 1,072 to 863 and Narcotics (2,364 to 2,293), Postal Laws dropped from 2,328 to 2,045. National Stolen Property Act (1,106 to 1,096) and Crimes on Federal Reservations (541 to 587) showed slight changes. Increases took place in 37 districts ranging from 323 in Western Texas to 1 in Maryland, Eastern Michigan and Minnesota. Decreases took place in 52 districts ranging from 414 in Southern California to 1 in Northern Oklahoma.

TERMINATED - Cases terminated decreased 643 or 1.9 per cent under the previous year's total. Of the total of 31,886 closed, 21,801 involving 25,987 defendants were by plea of guilty, 2,843 (involving 3,619 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 781 (involving 1,236 defendants) not guilty.

PENDING - With 12,058 cases, the pending caseload showed an increase of 6.6 per cent over 11,311* cases pending at the close of fiscal year

1965. 10,311 were in a triable status while 1,747 were in a fugitive or other status beyond the control of the United States Attorneys.

GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury Proceedings comprised of 17,064 indictments and 645 No True Bills amounted to 17,709 an increase of 1.1 per cent over the previous fiscal year for the highest total since fiscal year 1954.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

RECEIVED - Complaints received reached 123,520 for the highest total in the history of the Department. This is .91 per cent more than the 122,401 received in fiscal year 1965. Southern California with 8,975 had the most complaints and Southern New York with 5,604 and Western Texas with 5,010 were the next highest. 81,667 of the complaints were in eleven offenses as shown below:

CLOSED - 89,296 complaints were closed during 1966 without reaching court dockets. Of this number, 77,453 or 86.7 per cent of the total were closed by declination of prosecution.

PENDING - Criminal complaints pending as of June 30, 1966 rose to 15,673, an increase of 1,864 or 13.5 per cent over the 13,809 pending as of June 30, 1965.

CIVIL CASES

FILED - Civil cases filed amounting to 30,070 exceeded the previous all time high of 28,839 filed in fiscal year 1965 by 4.3 per cent or 1,231. 48 districts had increases, three had the same and 41 districts showed decreases from the previous year. 15,240 or 50.2 per cent of the total was in sixteen districts having filings ranging from 512 to 1,401. Tax Lien cases with 4,708 and Tort cases with 2,148 had 15.7 and 7.1 per cent respectively of the cases filed.

TERMINATED - With 57 districts showing increases, civil cases terminated rose to an all time high of 29,224. This total exceeded fiscal year 1965's total by 1131 or 4.0 per cent. Increases ranged from 390 in Eastern New York to 3 in Canal Zone and Puerto Rico while decreases ranged from 1 in Western Pennsylvania to 159 in Connecticut.

1,276 of these cases were suits in which the government as defendant was sued for \$150,916,579. 668 of them involving \$46,113,159 were closed by compromises amounting to \$10,679,886 and 213 involving \$14,035,653 resulted in judgments against the government amounting to \$7,646,071. The remaining 395 cases involving \$90,747,785 were won by

the government thus bringing the savings to \$132,590,640, an increase of \$26,486,258 or 25.0 per cent from the \$106,104,382 saved in fiscal year 1965.

PENDING - Civil cases pending as of the close of the fiscal year increased by 846 or 3.5 per cent to 24,828. 10,944 or 44.1 per cent of the caseload was in twelve districts with caseloads ranging from 1,428 in Eastern New York to 528 in Southern Ohio. Tax Lien cases with 3,680 dropped to 14.8 per cent of the total as compared to 4,134 or 17.1 per cent of the total pending as of June 30, 1965. Land cases with 2,014 or 8.1 per cent decreased from 2,118 or 8.5 per cent of the total.

CIVIL MATTERS

RECEIVED - 35,835 civil matters decreased 681 or 1.9 per cent over the 35,516 matters received in fiscal year 1965. Tax Lien matters with 4,783 and Tort matters with 2,245 comprised 13.3 per cent and 6.3 per cent respectively of the total. Delegated General Claims matters amounted to 10,372 or 28.9 per cent of the total. 20,514 or 57.2 per cent of the total were in nine districts having totals ranging from 1,042 in Illinois Southern to 1,736 in Middle Florida.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 8,107, an increase of 9.7 or 714 from the fiscal year 1965 total of 7,393.

PENDING - 10,935 civil matters were pending as of June 30, 1966 as compared to 13,008 as of June 30, 1965. This is a decrease of 2,073 or 15.9 per cent.

MAN-HOURS

A total of 182,953 man-hours were spent in court during fiscal year 1966. Following is a breakdown of those hours.

Based on an average employment of 657.2 each Assistant United States Attorney averaged 22.8 hours per month in courtroom work during the fiscal year.

COLLECTIONS

Collections for fiscal year 1966 reached \$74,707,531, an increase of \$9,642,526 or 14.8 per cent over the \$65,065,005 collected in fiscal year 1965. This year's amount represents a return of \$3.81 for each dollar of the \$19,611,000 appropriated for United States Attorneys' Offices for the year ending June 30, 1966.

PERSONNEL

During the year United States Attorneys' employment averaged 1,736

employees, 326 employees were appointed and 393 were separated a net decrease of 67 and 1,710 were on the rolls as of June 30, 1966. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney increased from 143.5 in fiscal year 1965 to 149.1 in the current year while cases terminated increased from 90.7 to 93.7.

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CHART NO. 1 CASES PENDING IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

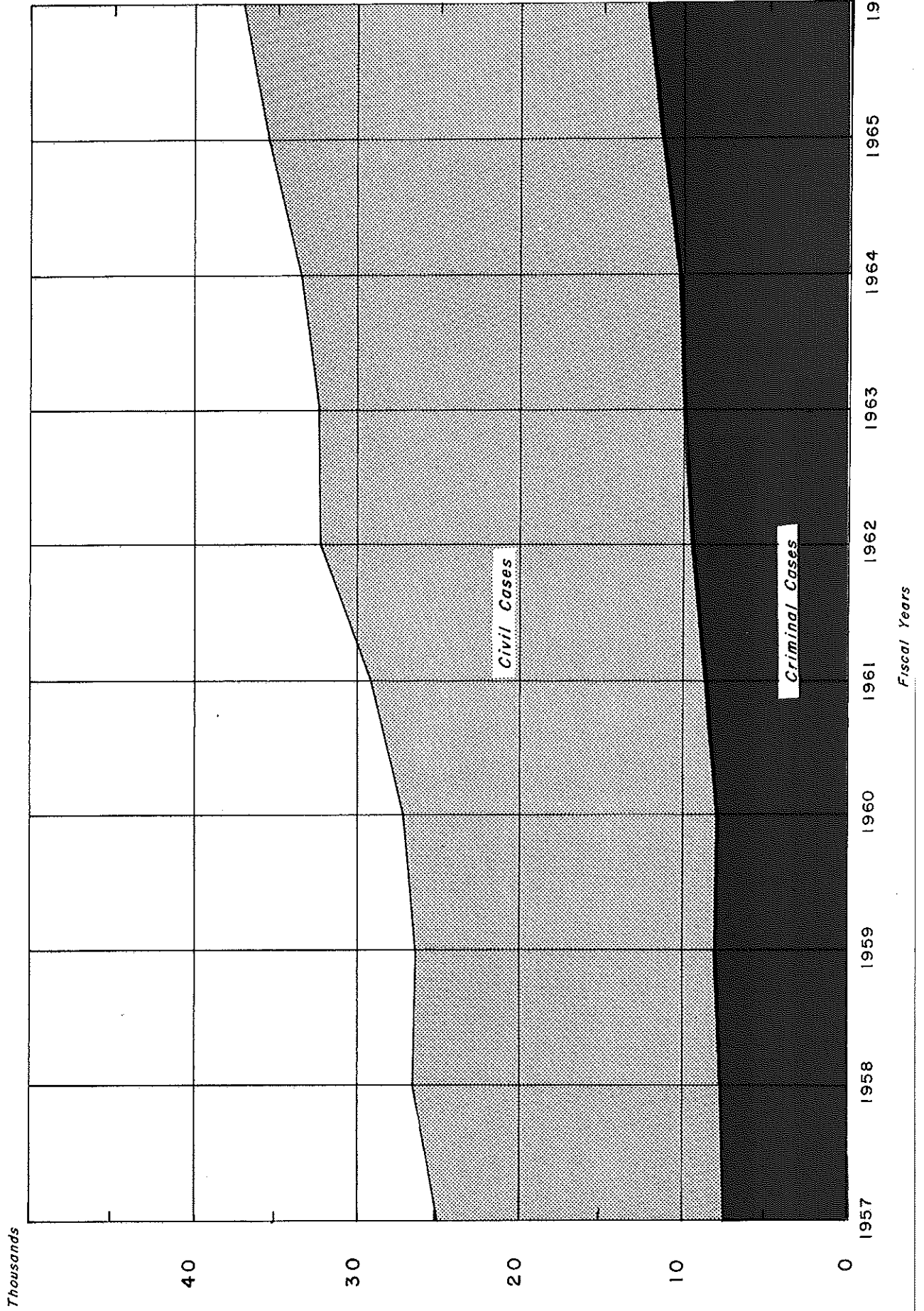


CHART NO. 2

IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

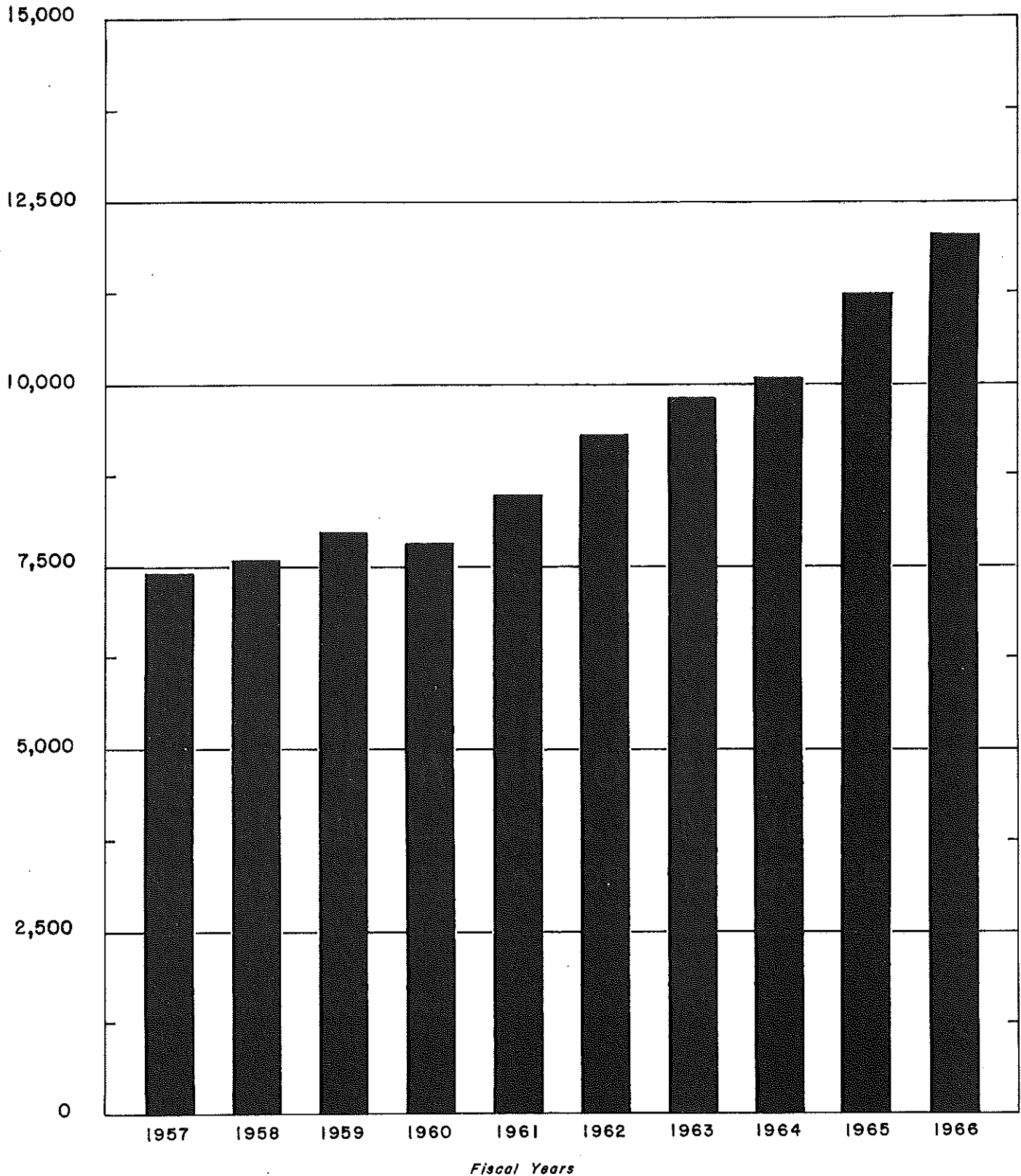

TOTAL 12,058 CASES

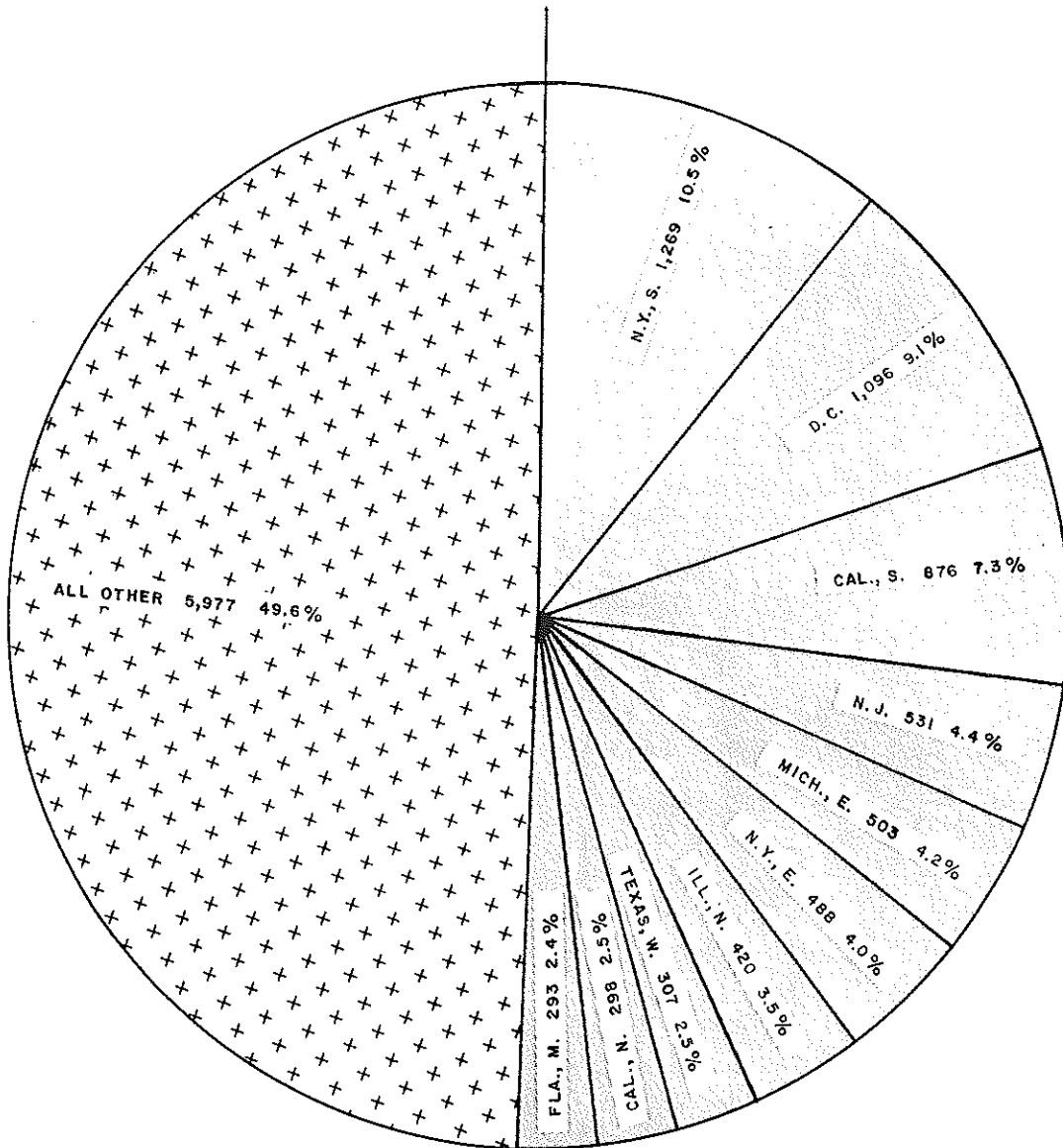


CHART NO. 4

 TOTAL 12,058 CASES

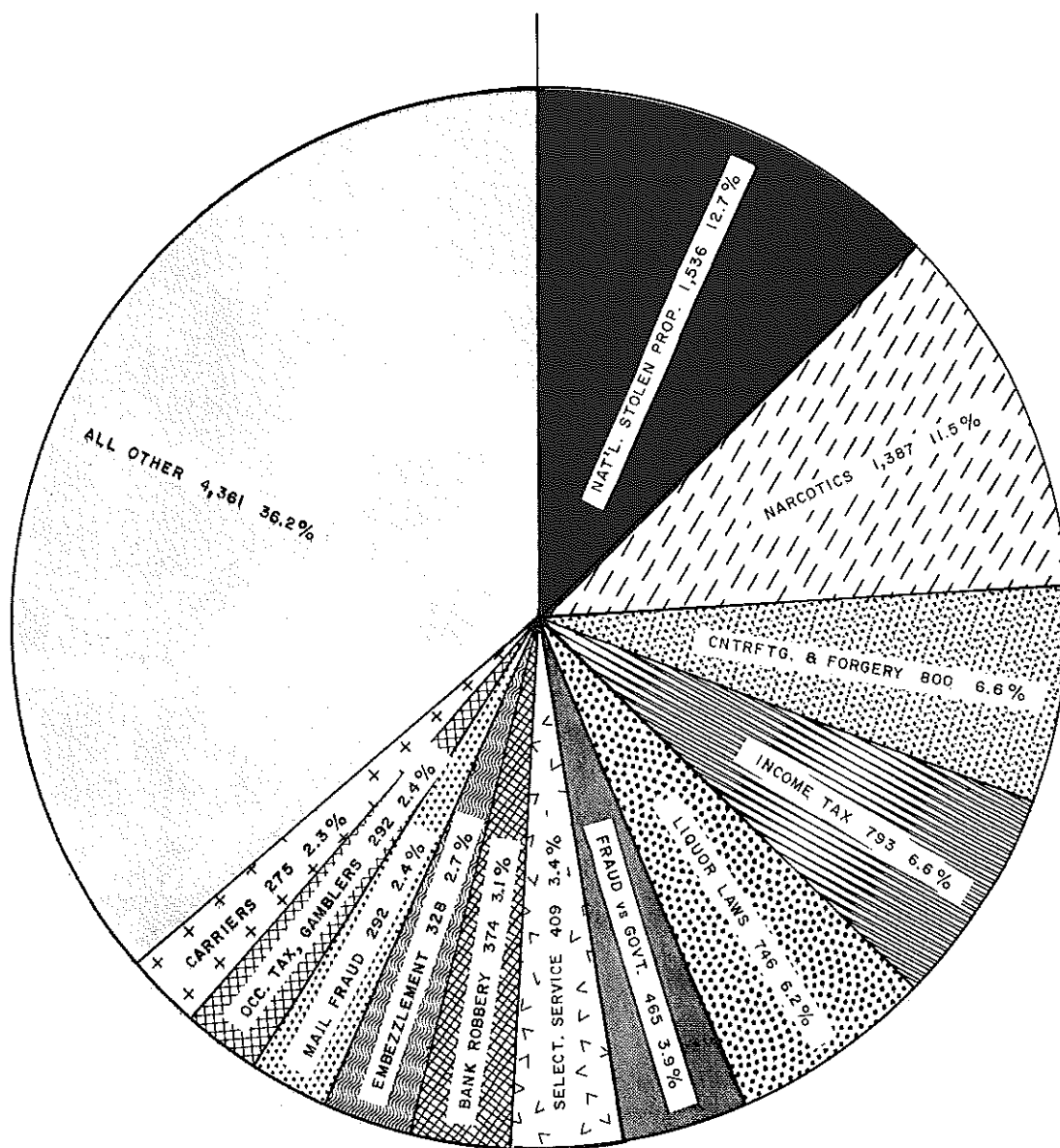


CHART NO. 5

 TOTAL 12,058 CASES

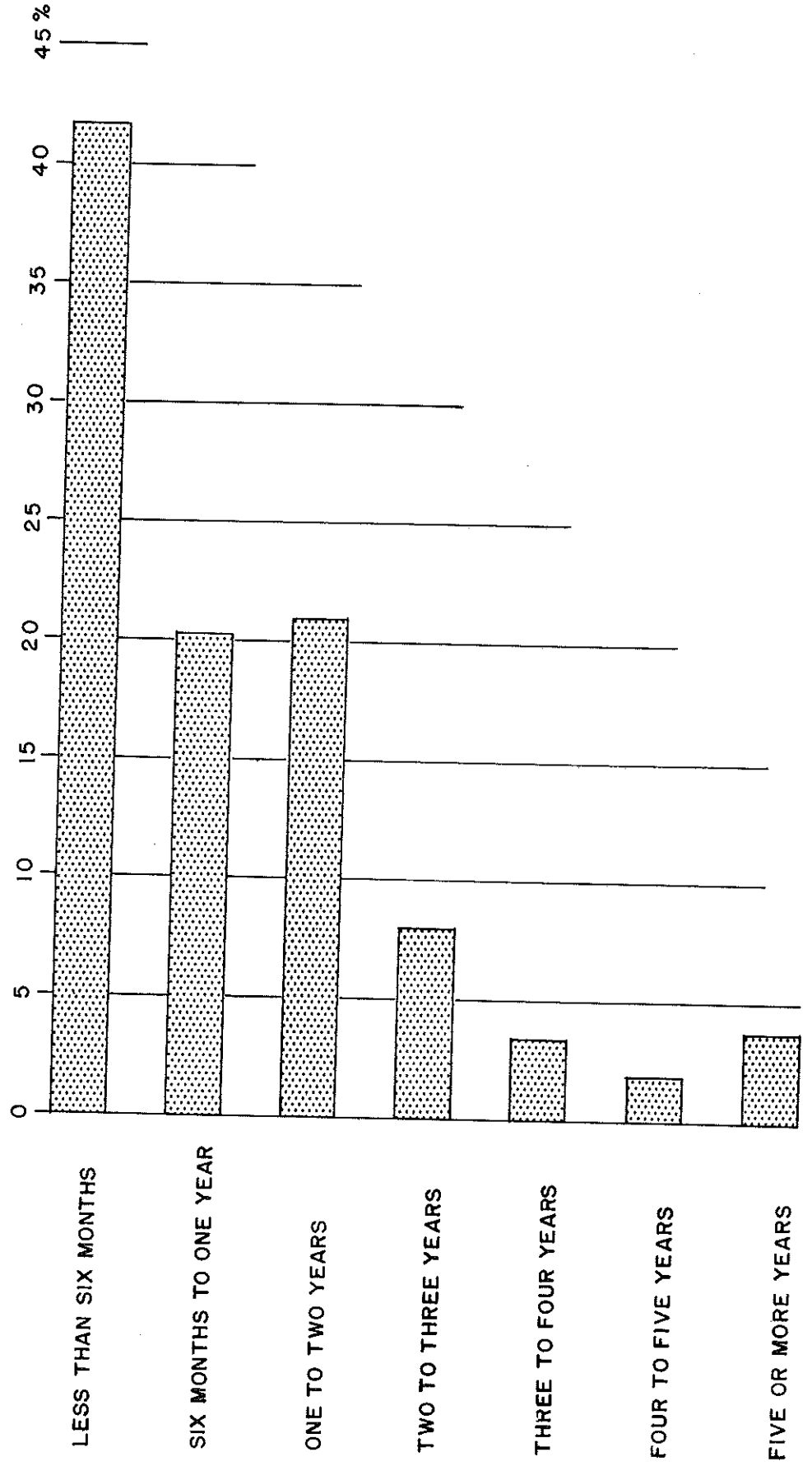


CHART NO. 6

IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

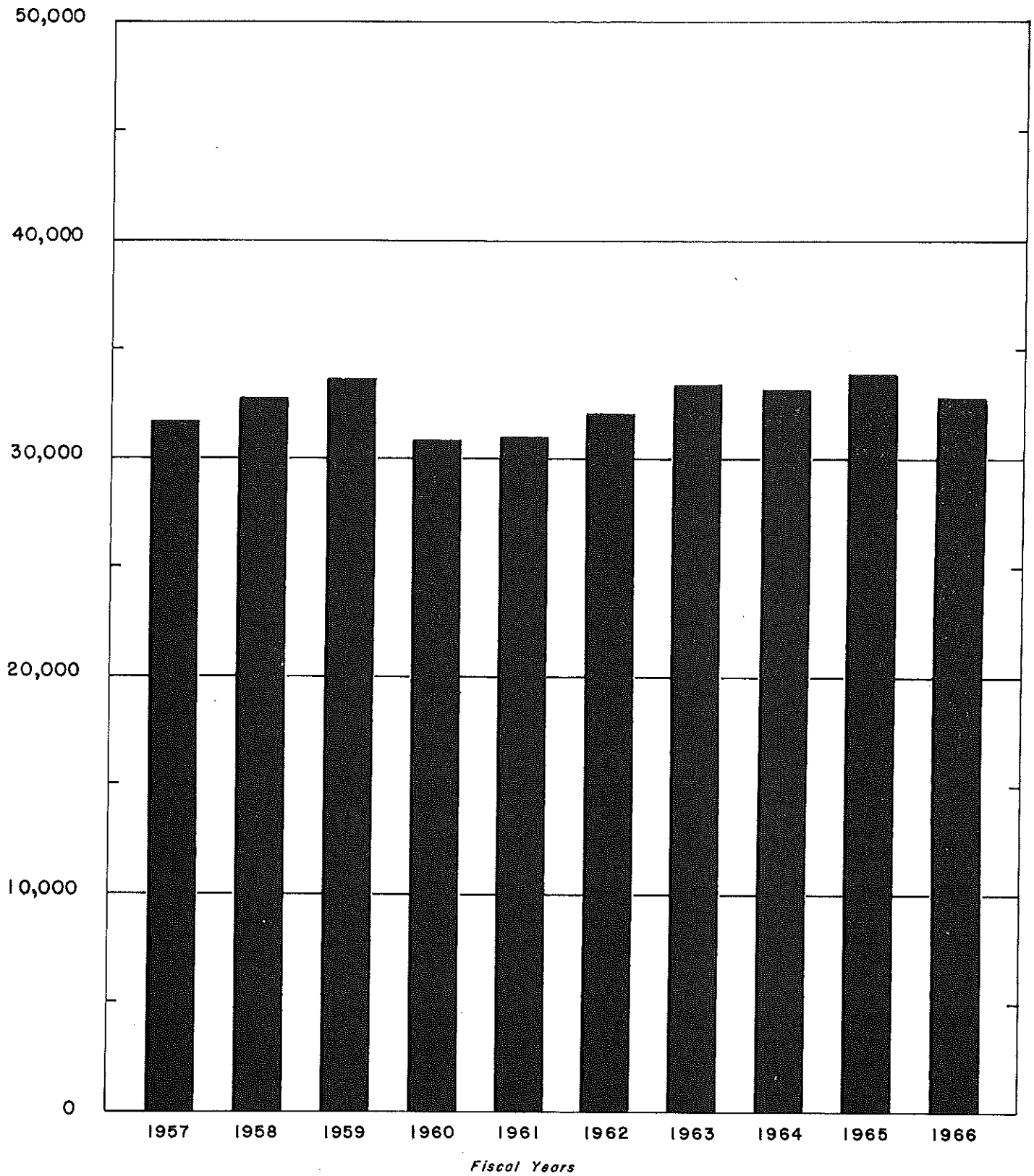


CHART NO. 7

 IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

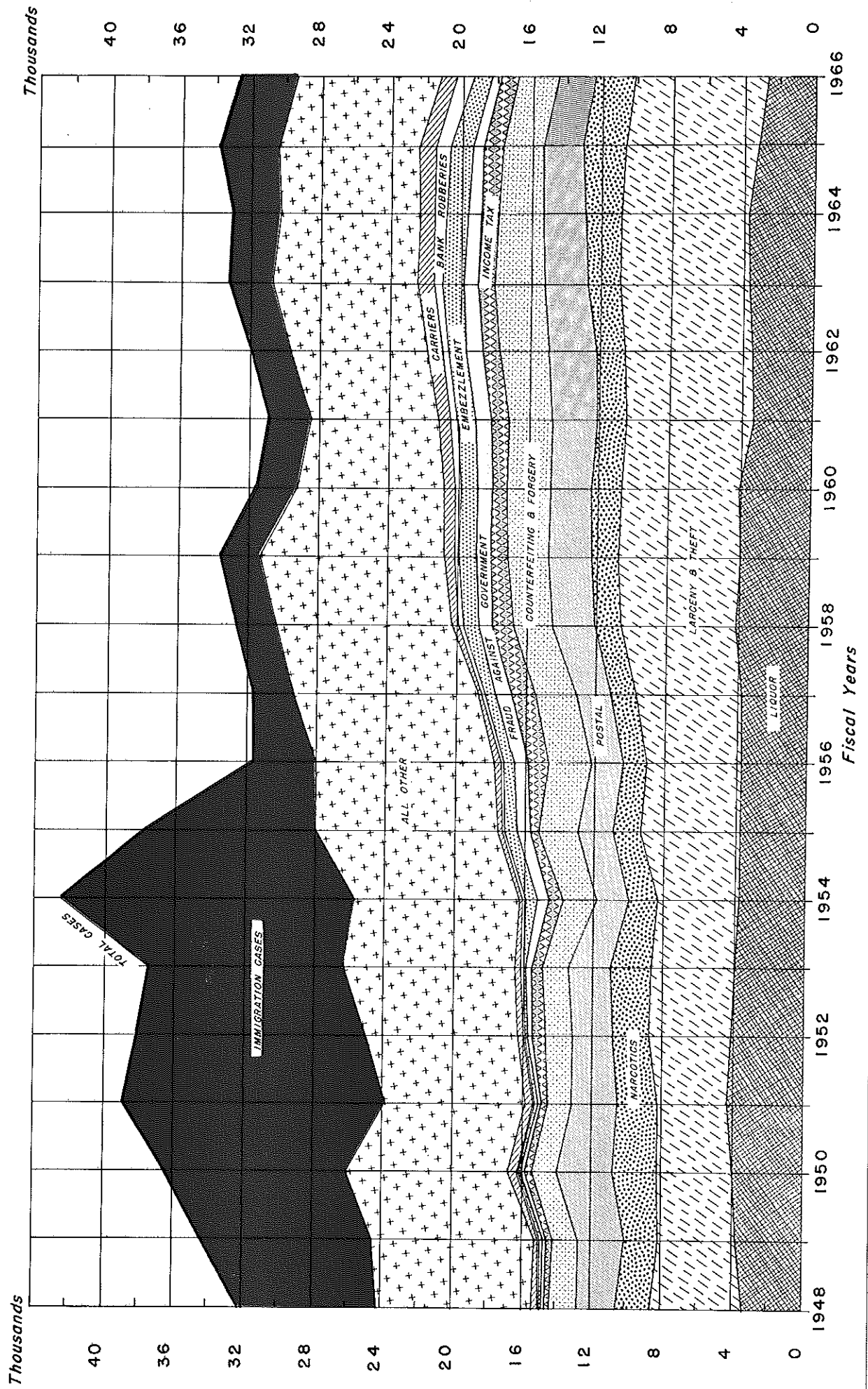

PROCEEDINGS BEFORE GRAND JURY IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

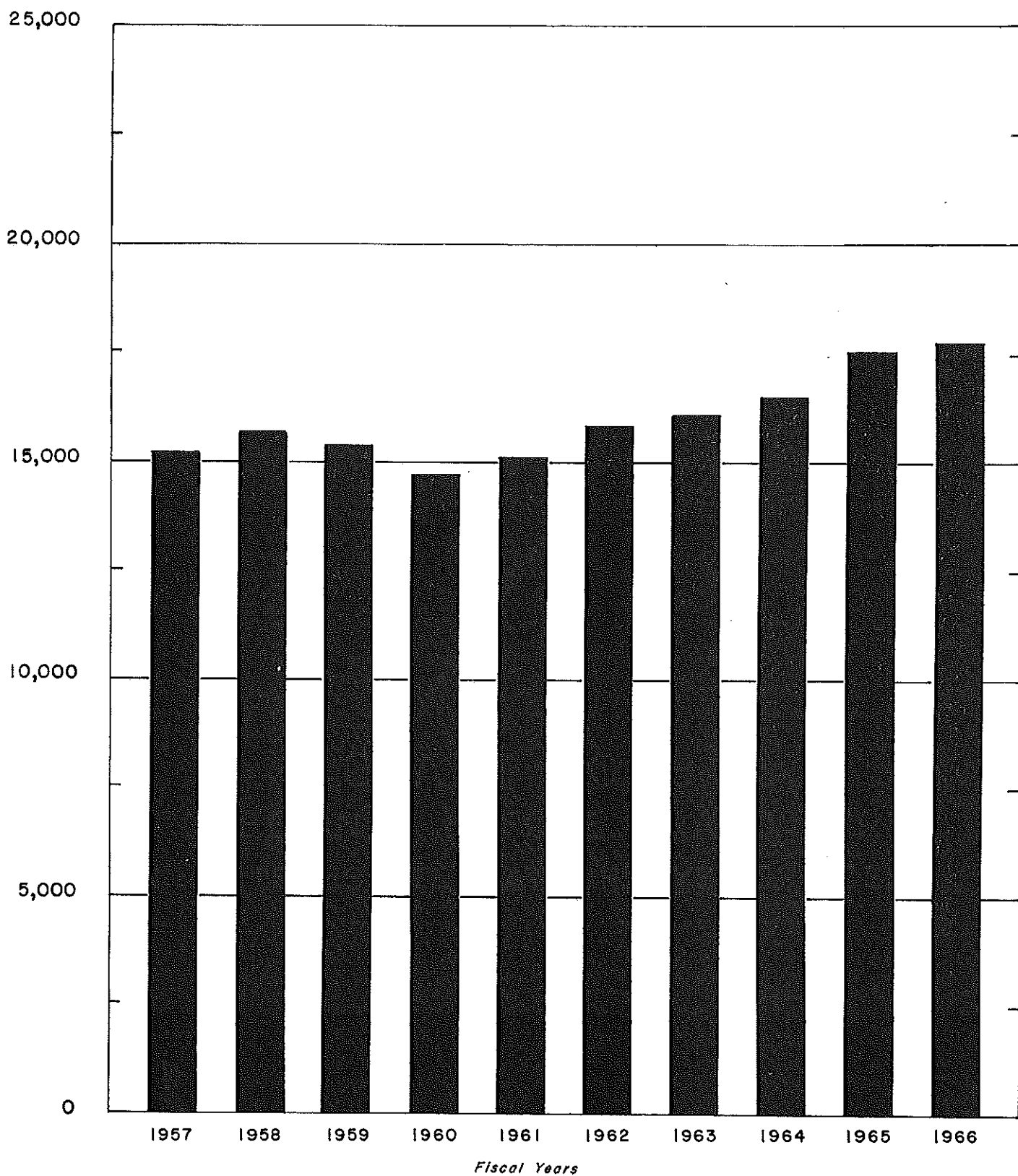

CRIMINAL CASES TERMINATED IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

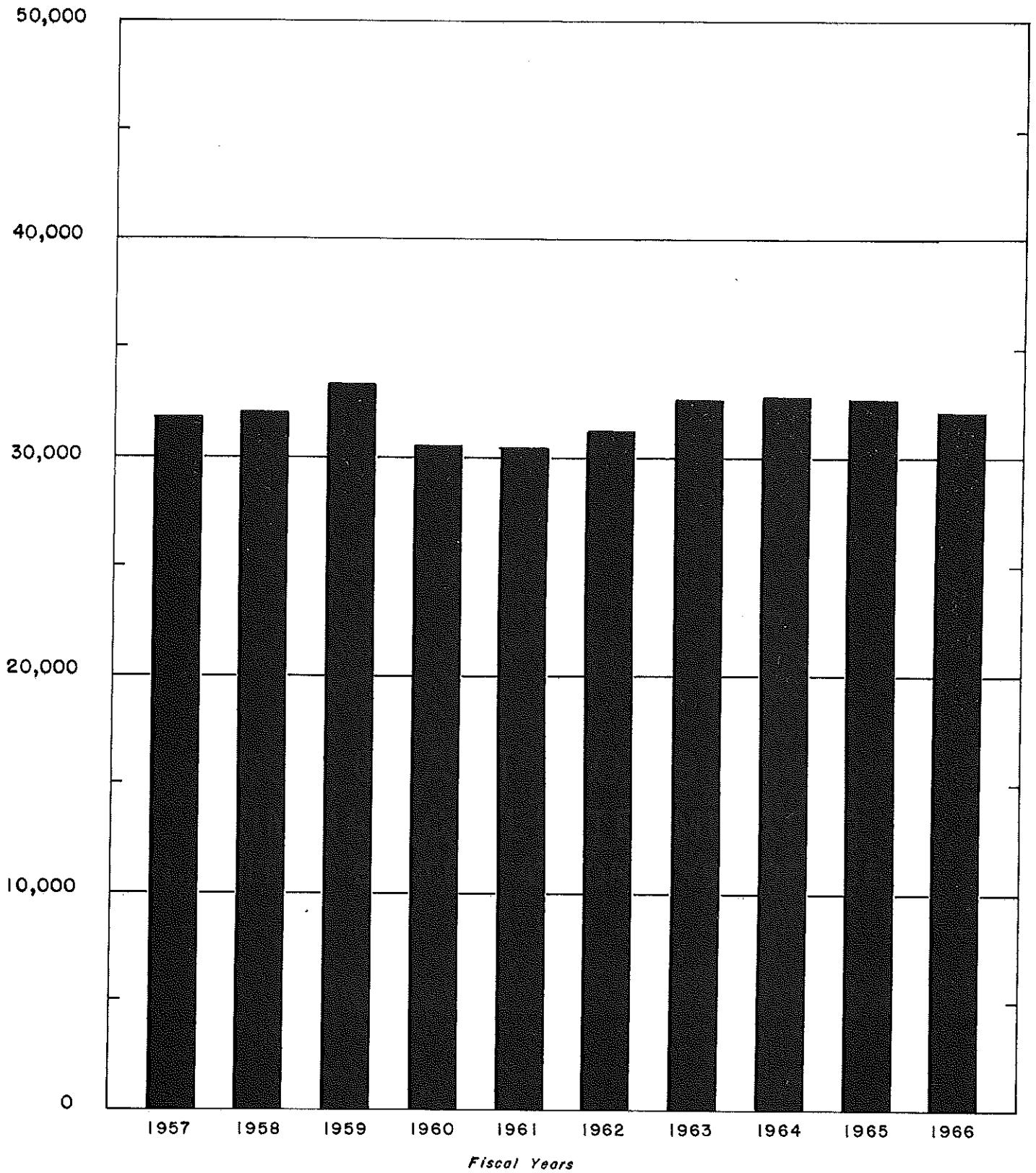

TRIALS IN CRIMINAL CASES IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

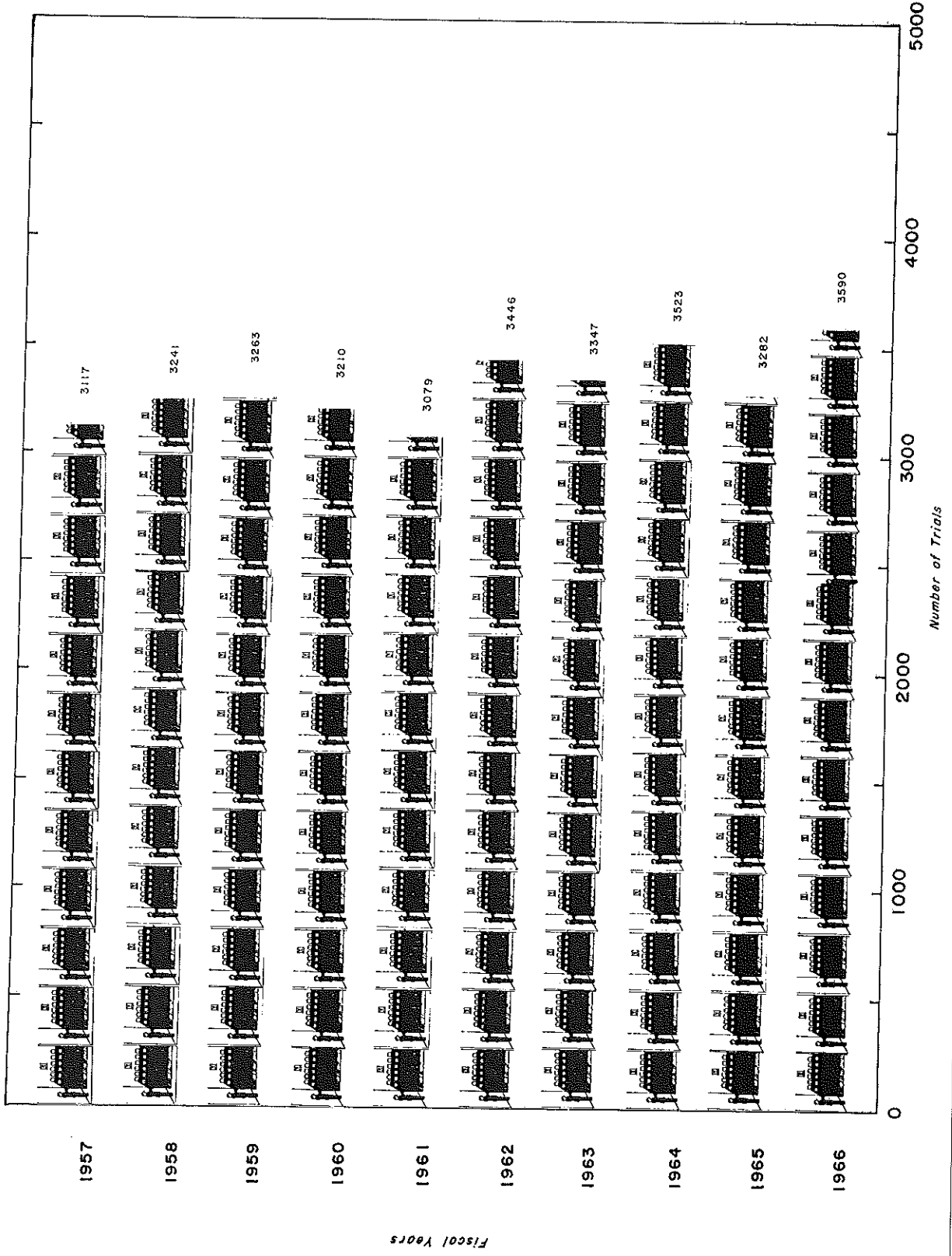

IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

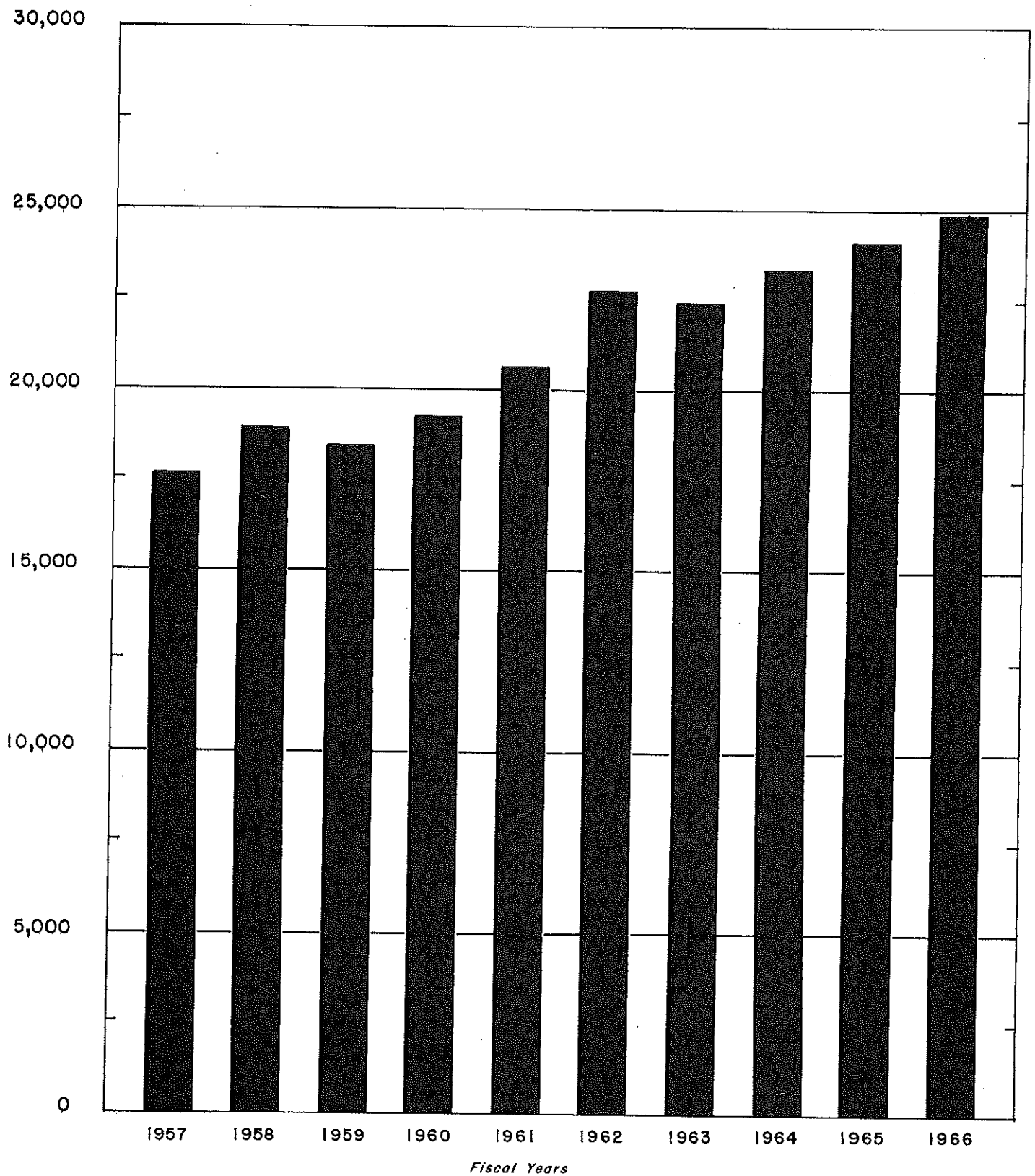

TOTAL 24,828 CASES

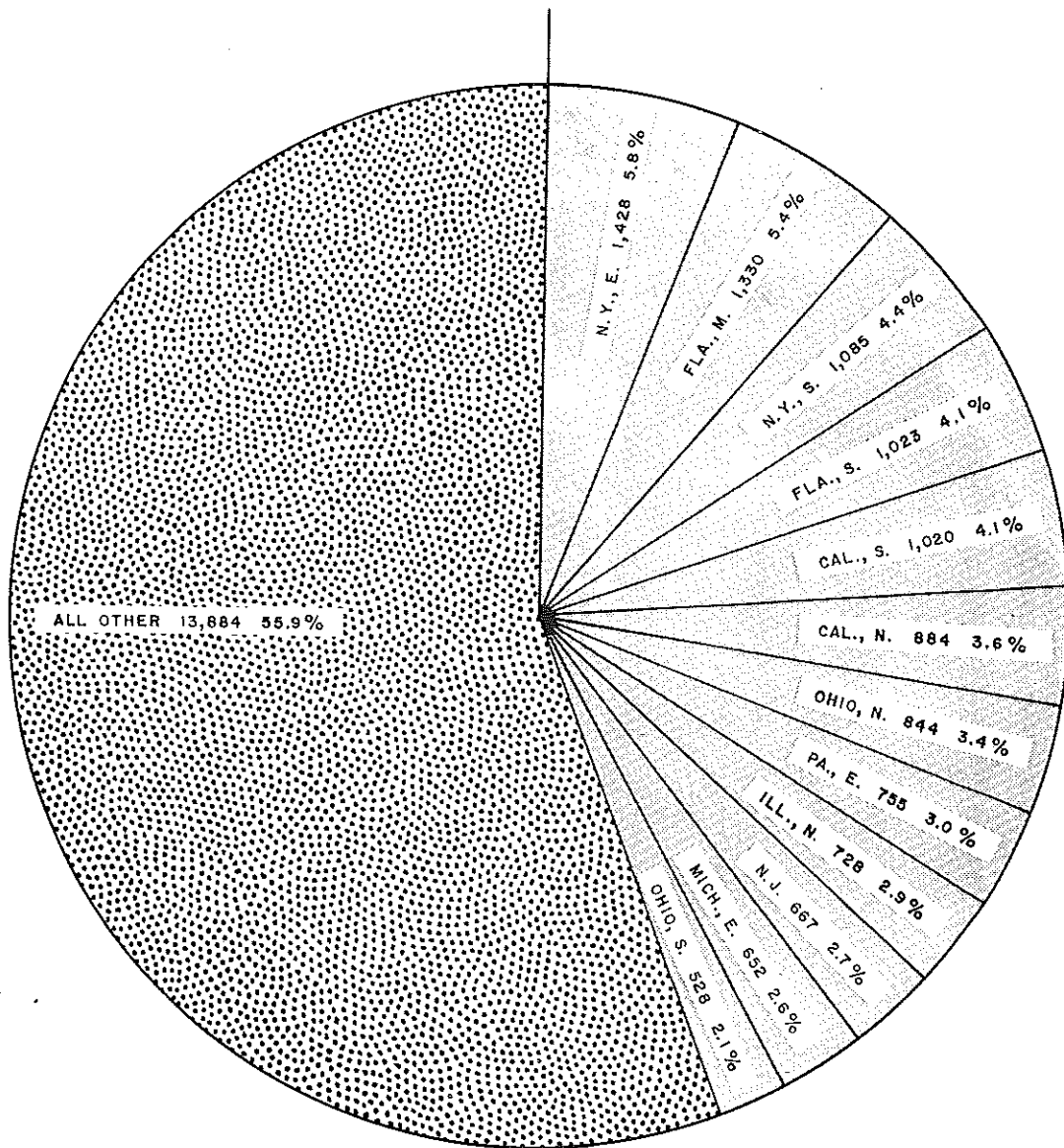
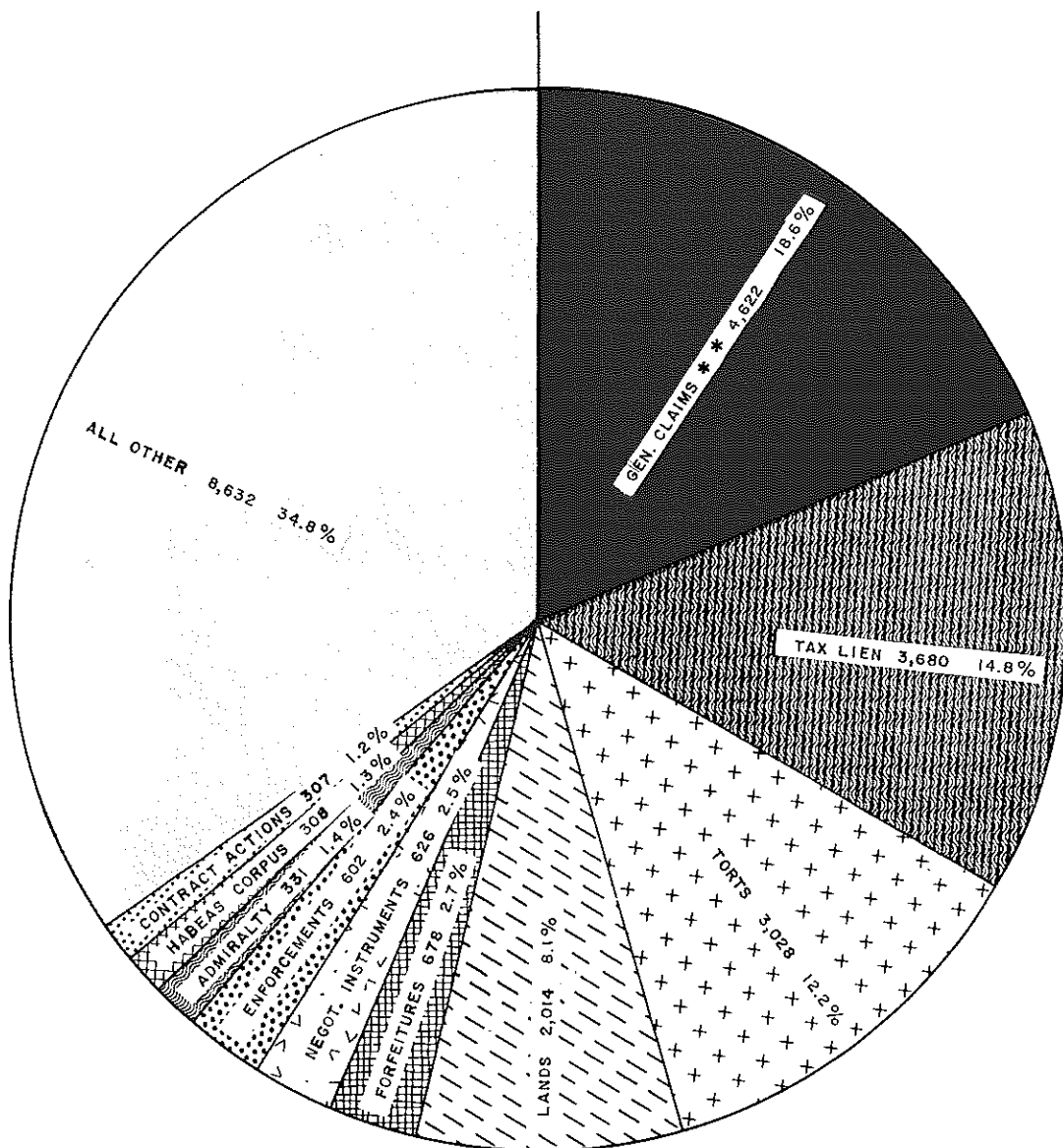
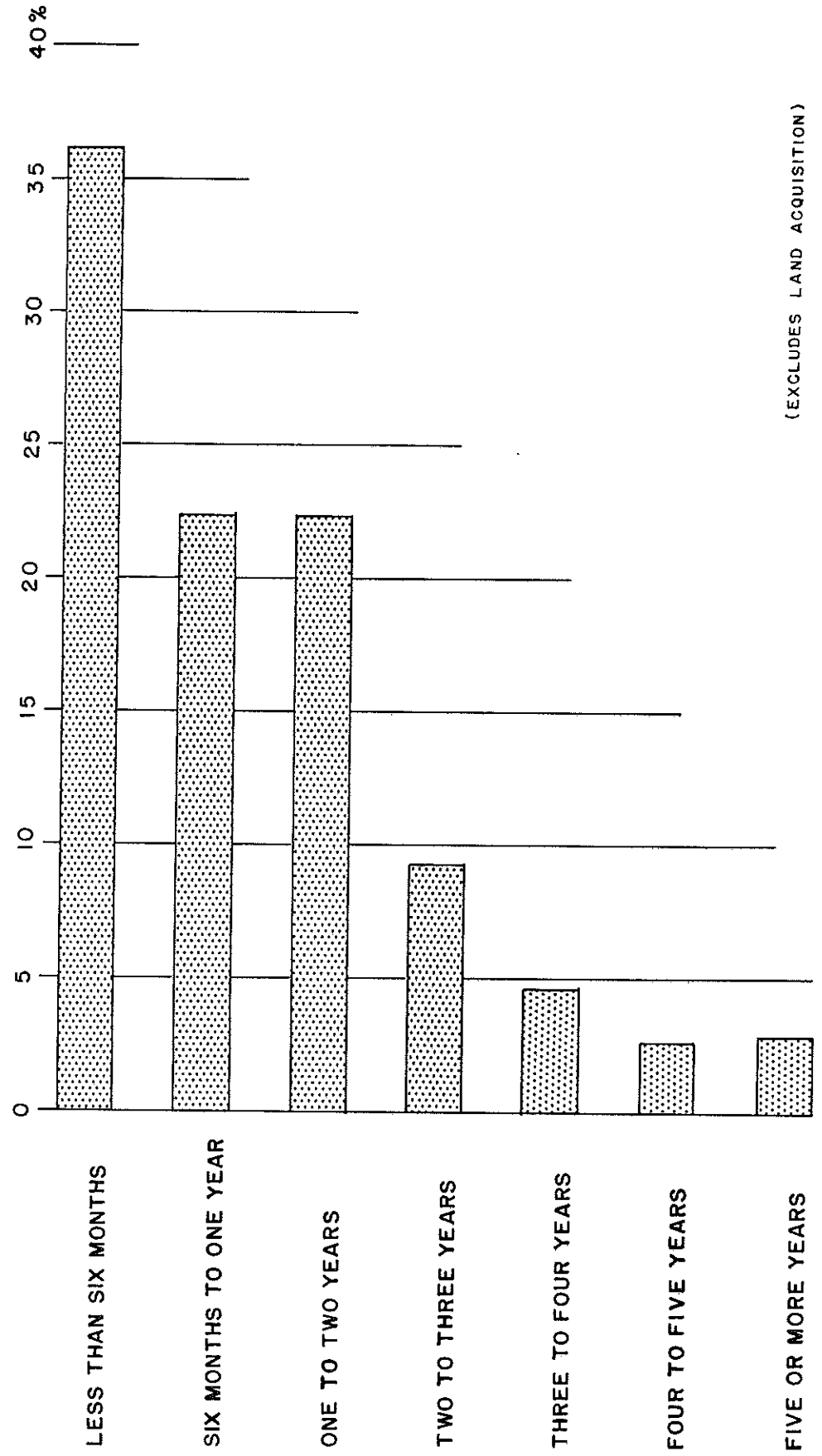


CHART NO. 13

IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

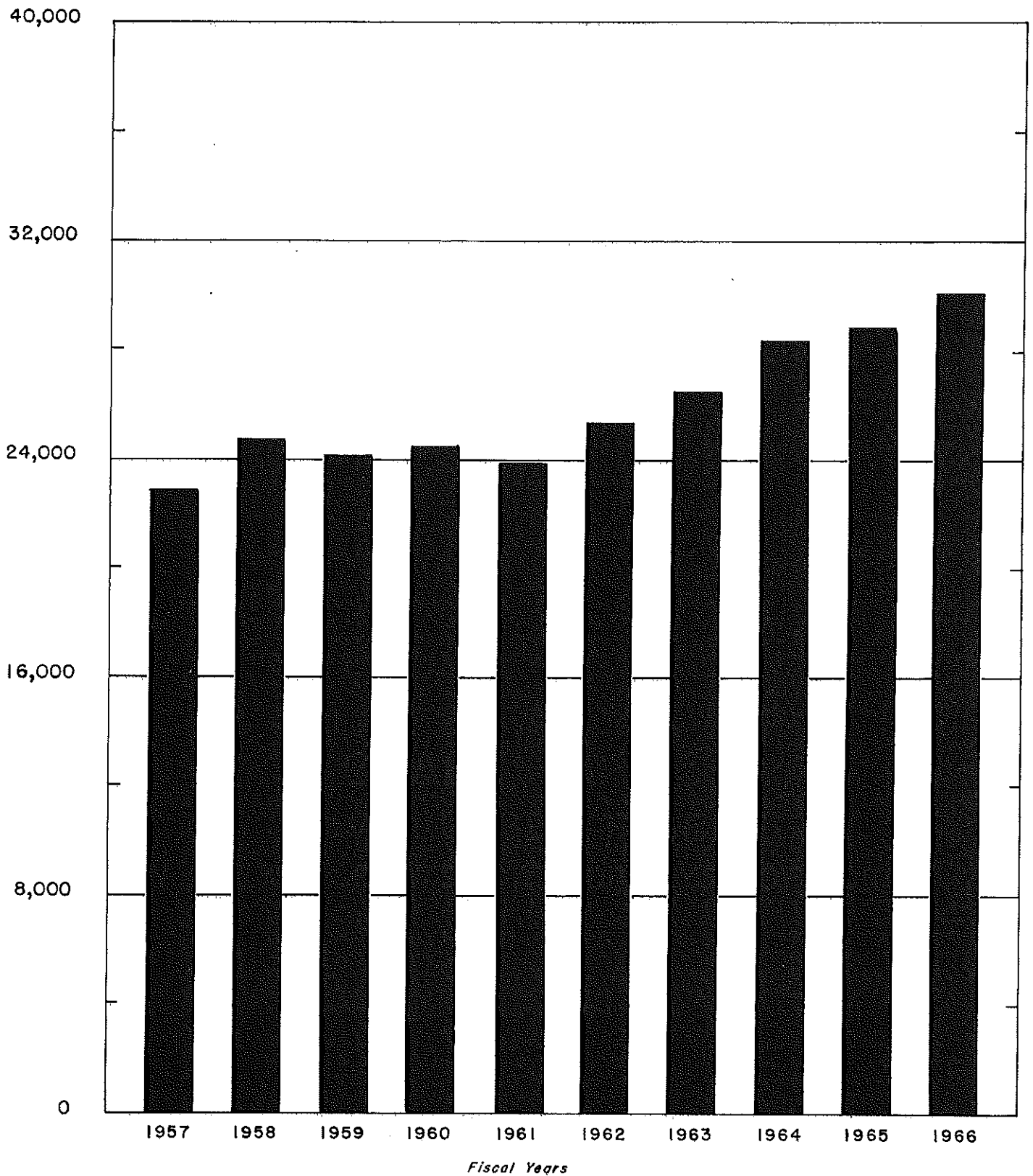

IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

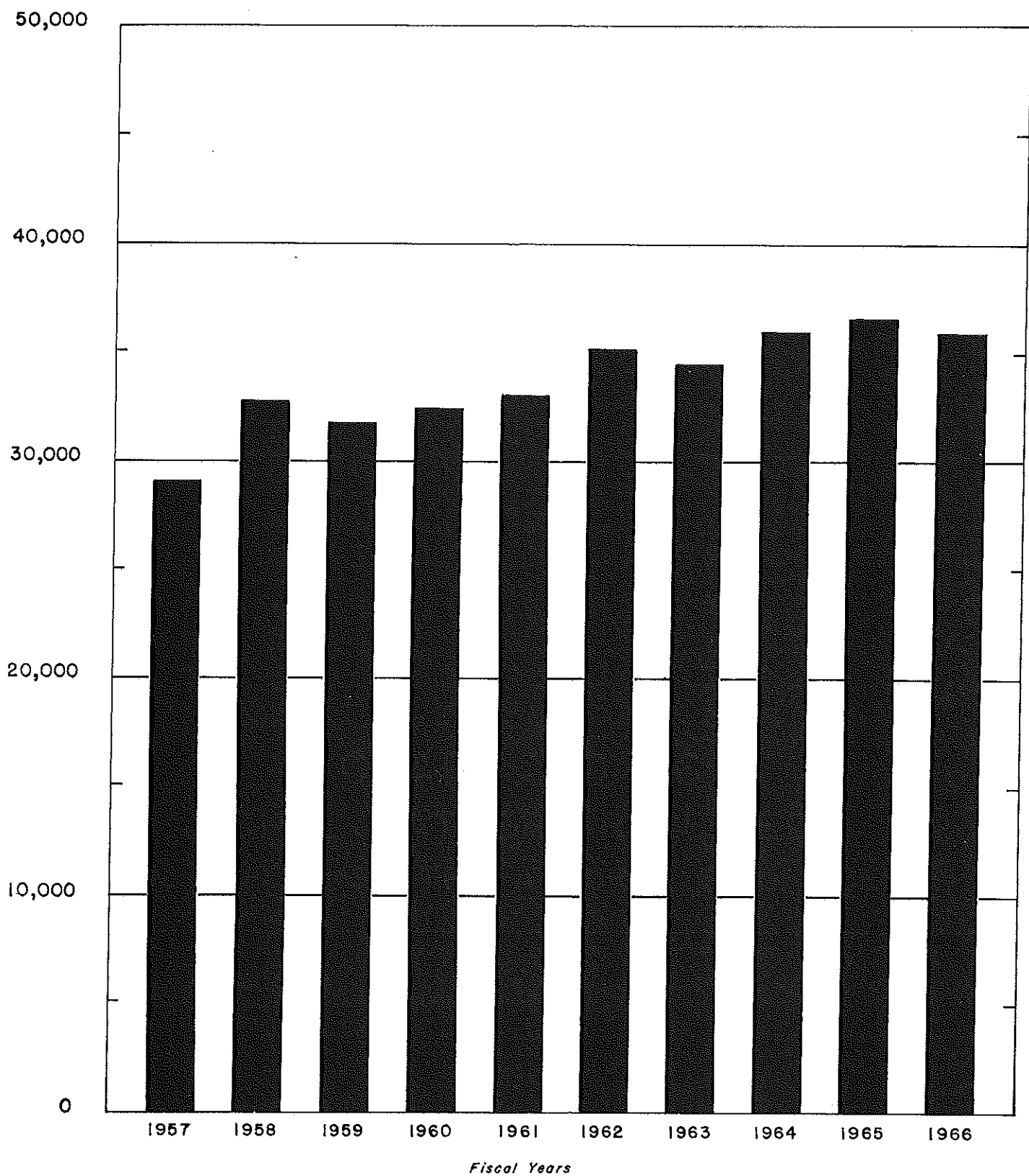


CHART NO. 17

IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

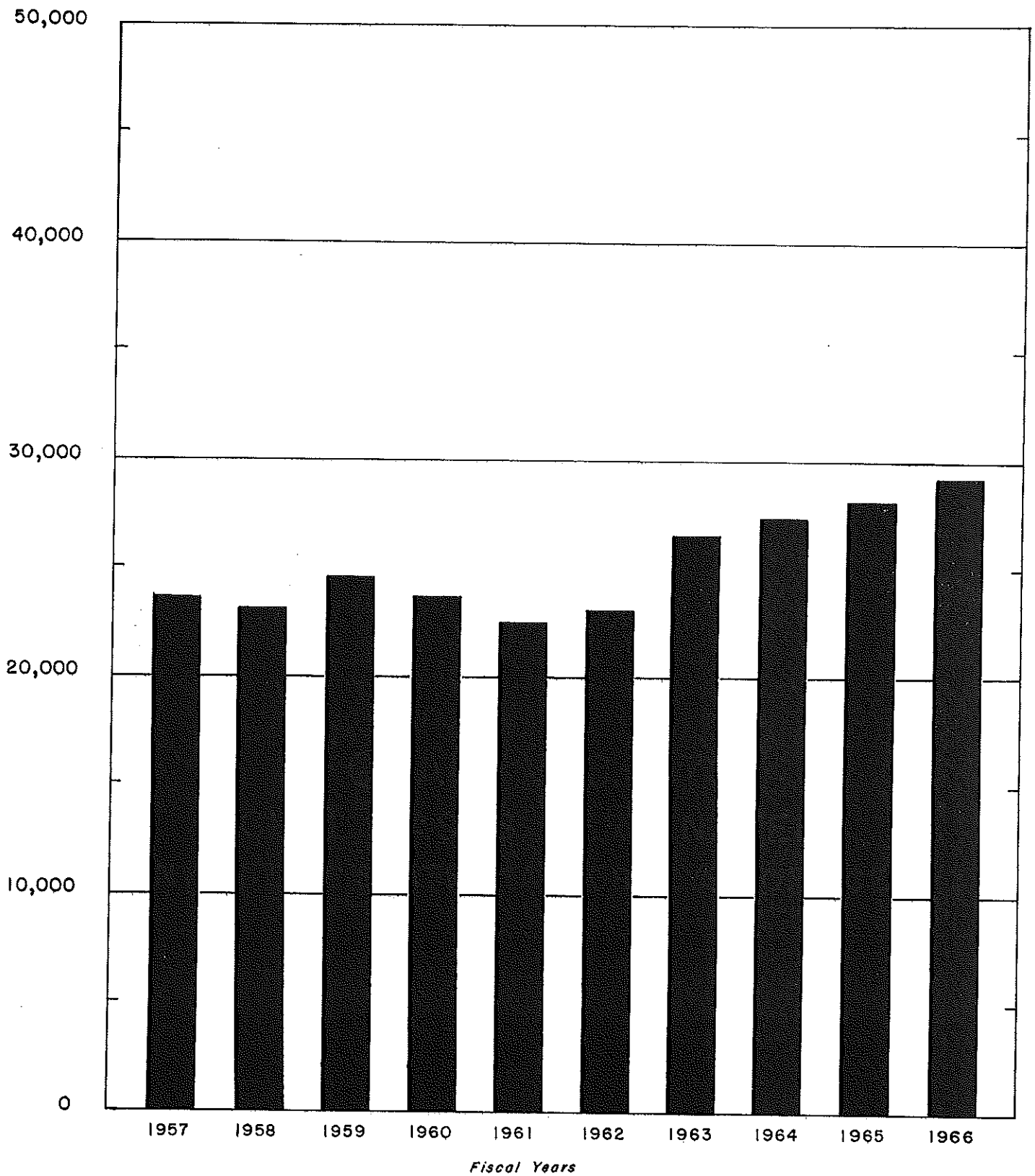

APPROPRIATIONS AND COLLECTIONS IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

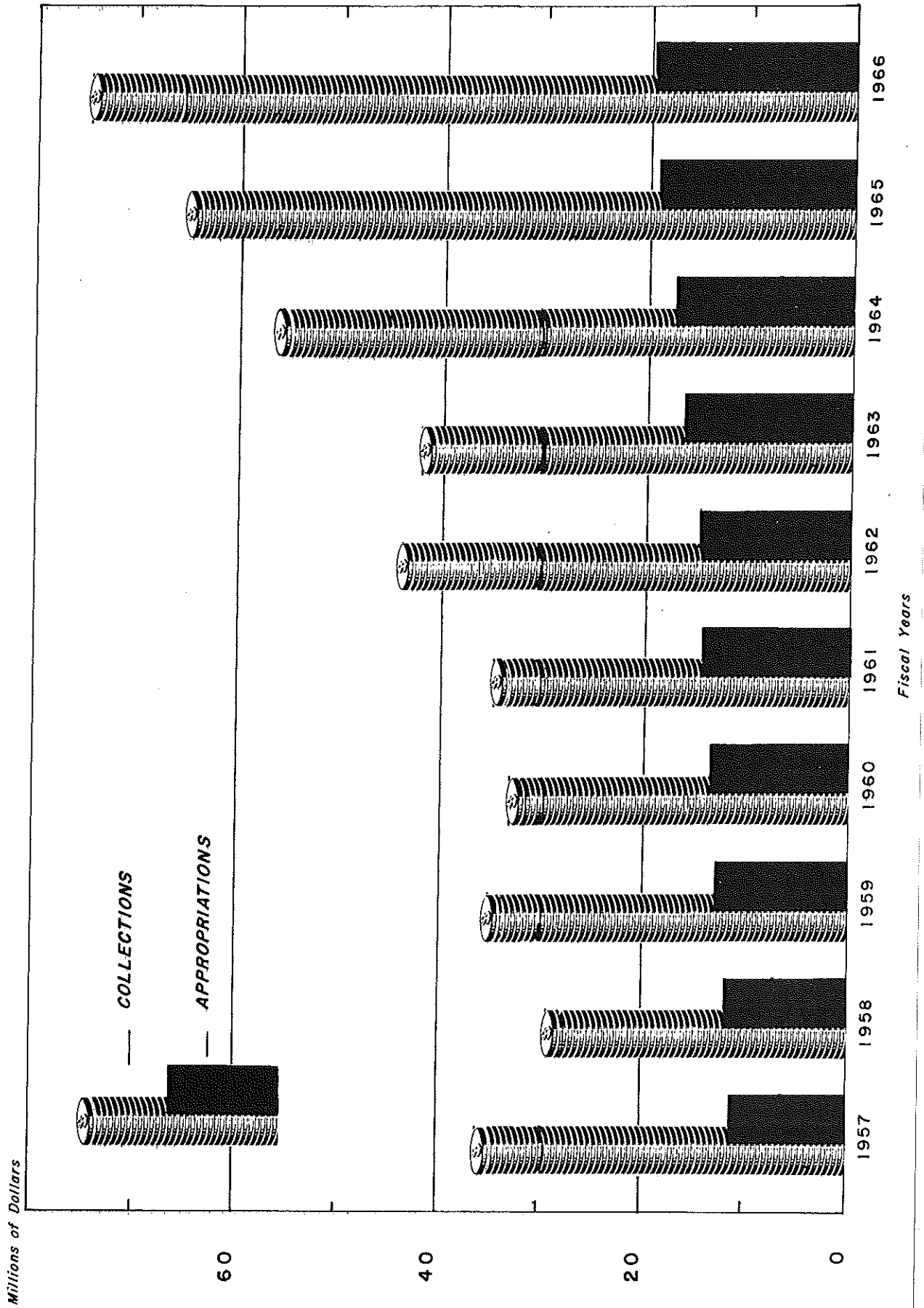

ACCESSIONS AND SEPARATIONS IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

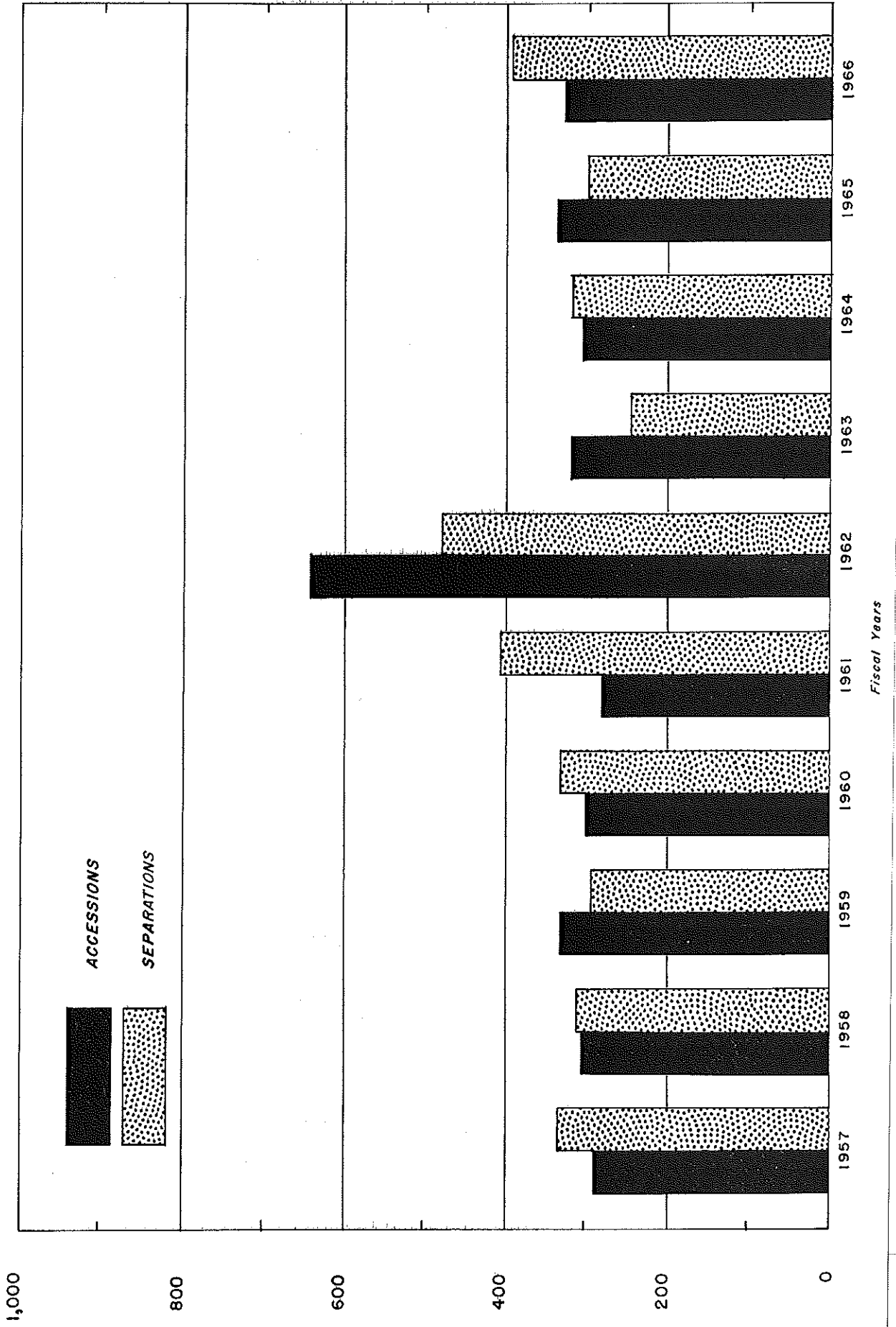
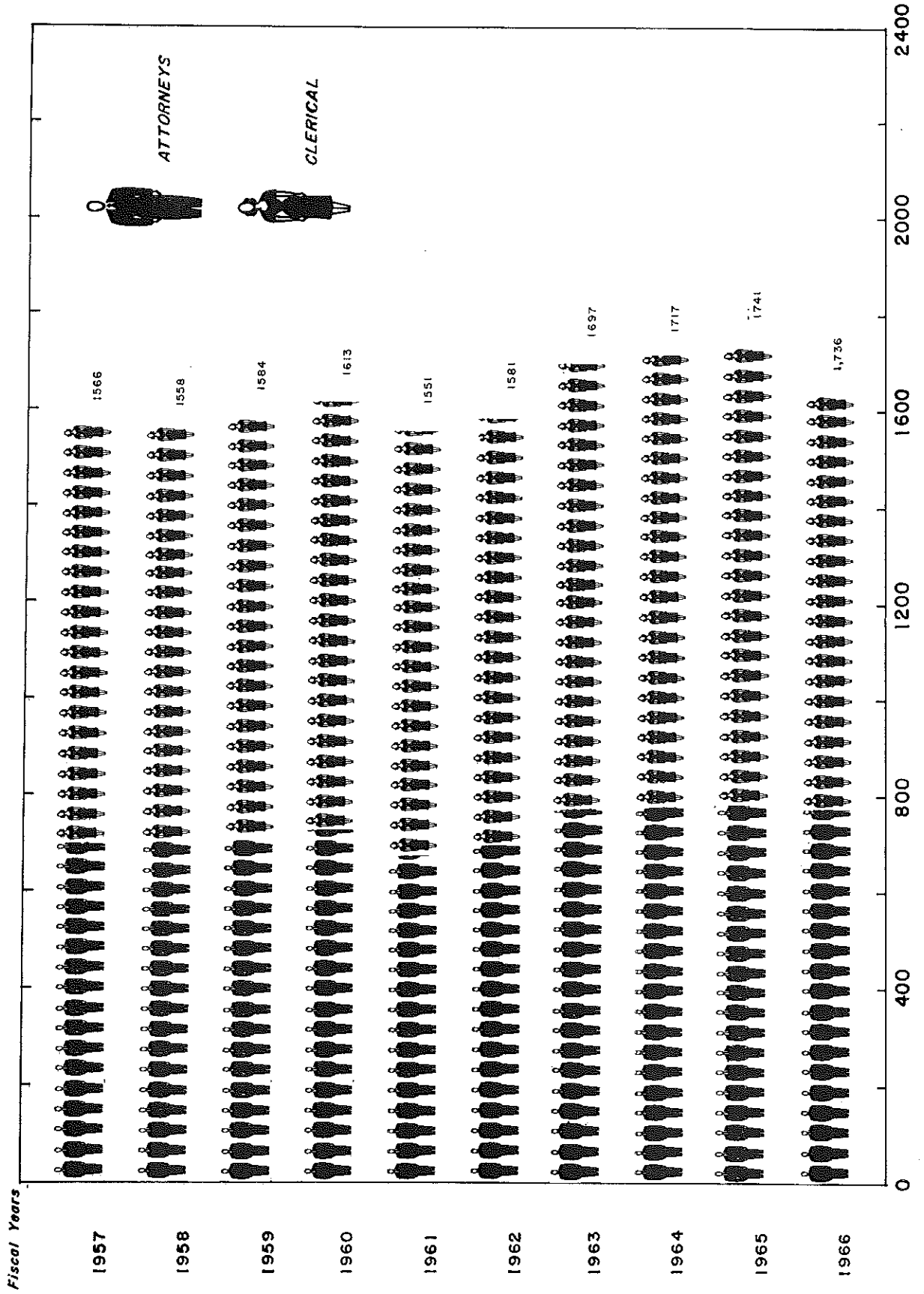
