**ORDER REQUIRING STATUS REPORT**

On January 13, 2009, Respondent submitted a Motion to Compel Exide Technologies (“Exide”) to Produce Documents Requested by Subpoena *Duces Tecum* and a Motion to Compel Entek International, LLC (“Entek”) to Produce Documents Requested by Subpoena *Duces Tecum*. In each of these motions, Respondent asserts that the non-parties have failed to produce responsive documents.

Non-party Exide submitted an opposition on January 22, 2009. Exide states that it has been working diligently to comply with the subpoena and will continue to do so, but that, due to the breadth of the documents sought, it has been unable to complete production.

Non-party Entek submitted an opposition on January 22, 2009. Entek states that it has substantially complied with the subpoena, as modified by an agreement between Entek and Respondent, and that it intends to produce additional documents as promptly as it can.

Respondent’s counsel is hereby ORDERED to provide a report on the status of production and whether its motions have been rendered moot.
