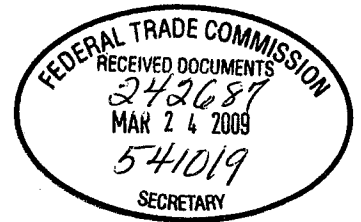

ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME


On March 23, 2009, Respondent submitted a motion requesting a modification of the Scheduling Order, as amended by Order dated February 4, 2009 ("Amended Scheduling Order"). Respondent seeks to extend by one week certain dates relating to Respondent's expert, Dr. Mark Stevenson. Respondent has demonstrated good cause for seeking this extension. Respondent represents that Complaint Counsel does not oppose the one-week extensions requested by Respondent.

Respondent's motion is GRANTED.

It is hereby ORDERED that: (a) the March 20, 2009 deadline to provide the expert witness report of Dr. Stevenson be extended through March 27, 2009; (b) the March 27, 2009 deadline for Complaint Counsel to identify rebuttal experts and provide expert reports in response to the expert report of Dr. Stevenson be extended through April 3, 2009; (c) the April 3, 2009 deadline for the expert deposition of Dr. Stevenson (and the deposition(s) of rebuttal experts, if any, identified by Complaint Counsel in response to Dr. Stevenson's expert report) be extended through April 10, 2009; and (d) the April 6, 2009 deadline for filing motions *in limine* and motions to strike, only as such motions relate to the expert report or deposition of Dr. Stevenson or to corresponding rebuttal evidence, be extended through April 13, 2009.

All other dates in the Amended Scheduling Order, including deadlines relating to experts other than Dr. Stevenson, and the hearing date, remain unaffected.
