## ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO EXTEND MSC'S TIME TO OPPOSE THIRD-PARTY LEAR CORPORATION'S MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

Respondent MSC.Software Corporation, with the consent of third-party Lear Corporation ("Lear"), hereby moves for an order granting MSC additional time to respond to Lear's March 8, 2002 Motion to Quash Subpoena Duces Tecum.

The parties are engaged in discussions relating to the substance of Lear's document production obligations pursuant to MSC's subpoena and the issues raised in Lear's Motion. Although the parties believe that Lear's motion may not ultimately require this Court's attention, Lear wishes to preserve its rights and not withdraw its motion at this time.
