9 FAM 40.11 NOTES

Changes

1. This Change Transmittal issue updates to **9 FAM 40.11 Notes**. Section N11, Physical or mental disorders with harmful behavior and substance-related disorders and the effects of INA 212(a)(1)(a)(iii) and INA 212(a)(1)(a)(iv), was substantially rewritten. Section N12.3-2 was removed and section 12.3-1 and subsequent sections were renumbered.
2. **Change Transmittal** has replaced the term, Transmittal Letter. Change Transmittal was selected as being more appropriate in this age of electronic information transmission. The FAM volume's transmittal acronym and numerical series remains in place.
3. Revisions since the last update appear in *italic* and *dark magenta*. Other than formal titles, the italic will be removed the next time the material is updated. Only current changes will appear in italic. Italic provides a historical record of changes.
4. Officers are reminded that Department-issued materials not codified in the Foreign Affairs Manual or its supplemental Foreign Affairs Handbook series generally have no regulatory validity (see 2 FAM 1115.2).

Filing Instructions for Paper Copies

1. Remove and discard the old 9 FAM 40.11 Notes (CT:VISA-1407, 03-17-2010; 34 pages) and insert the new 9 FAM 40.11 Notes (CT:VISA-1452; 07-19-2010, 37 pages).
