### **9 FAM 41.41 PN1 VALIDITY OF D VISAS**

*(CT:VISA-1696; 09-19-2011)*

*You should normally issue individual* visas under the provisions of INA 101(a)(15)(D) for the full period of validity and the number of applications for admission indicated in the Reciprocity Schedule for the applicant's country of nationality.

### **9 FAM 41.41 PN2 WHEN DEROGATORY INFORMATION RECEIVED REGARDING HOLDER OF D VISA**

#### **9 FAM 41.41 PN2.1 Procedure to be Followed When Derogatory Information Received**

*(CT:VISA-1696; 09-19-2011)*

The nature of a crewman's occupation ordinarily makes *it difficult to locate him or her* for the purpose of physically canceling a revoked visa. Consequently, *you should follow* the procedures described in 9 FAM 41.41 PN2.2 when *you receive* information that would lead to a revocation of a D visa. In addition to the procedures described in 9 FAM 41.41 PN2.2, you should also include any known information about the crewman's current ship, employer, and next intended port of arrival in the United States.

#### **9 FAM 41.41 PN2.2 Cases Requiring Telegraphic Report to Department**

*(CT:VISA-1696; 09-19-2011)*

If *you receive* information indicating the holder of a D visa is ineligible under INA 212(a)(2)(C), (3)(A), (3)(B), (3)(C) or (3)(E), or is a known or suspected terrorist, dangerous criminal, or narcotic drug trafficker, and the visa has not been physically canceled, *you* should forward the information to

the Department by immediate telegram. The telegram should include all pertinent and available information about the alien and the ineligibility, along with the name of the carrier on which the crewman is serving, the date, and include as addressees DHS headquarters and the DHS district office having jurisdiction over the expected port of arrival. *You should follow this* telegram *with* the visa revocation report explained in 9 FAM 41.122.

## **9 FAM 41.41 PN2.3 Entering Name of Ineligible Crewman in Visa Lookout System**

*(CT:VISA-1696; 09-19-2011)*

Regardless of whether *you have submitted* the reports noted above, and whether *you have physically cancelled* the visa, *you* should enter the name of the ineligible crewman in the Consular Lookout and Support System (CLASS).
