

GUIDE TO LOCATING WHS POSTINGS IN FEDBIZOPPS

(To locate Washington Headquarters Services (WHS) postings, follow the steps below.)

STEP 1: CLICK ON THE AGENCY BUTTON, THEN TYPE "WASHINGTON HEADQUARTERS SERVICES."
