Mail: Prescription refill request cards are available at all BACH Pharmacy windows. For your convenience, the mail-in card has a space for patients to designate their preferred pick up date.

Online: Requests may be submitted at the BACH Online Pharmacy Refill Request website. **BACH Online Pharmacy Refill Request Website**

Note: The patient does not need to be present to pick up a prescription; however their designee needs to bring the patient's military identification card or a copy (front and back) to verify eligibility. Refills that have not been picked up within 10 days will be returned to stock, and a new request must be submitted.
