BACH observes Columbus Day

Limited Services during Day of No Scheduled Activity (DONSA)

FT. CAMPBELL, Ky. – In honor of the national observance of Columbus Day, Blanchfield Army Community Hospital (BACH) personnel will observe the federal holiday Monday Oct. 8, therefore all clinics and pharmacies will be closed. The Emergency and Urgent Care centers will remain open to provide acute and emergency medical care.

Limited services Friday, Oct. 5

Some patient services will be condensed during a Day of No Scheduled Activities (DONSA) Friday, Oct. 5. All Soldier health clinics, including LaPointe, Aviation and Byrd, will be closed during the DONSA and holiday. All other patients with appointments scheduled for Friday will be seen in their assigned clinics, including those scheduled for the Byrd Family Clinic. Patients may also walk-in to their assigned clinics from 9 a.m. to 11 and 1 p.m. to 3.

BACH's Appointment Line (270) 798-4677 or (931) 431-4677 will be staffed from 6 a.m. until 4 p.m. to schedule or cancel appointments. Appointments may also be scheduled or canceled 24 hours a day, seven days a week at www.TRICAREonline.com.

The Main Pharmacy within the hospital will be closed Friday, Oct. 5; however the Town Center Pharmacy will be open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. To ensure all prescriptions can be filled, the last pharmacy window ticket will be given at 4:45 p.m.
