

ATF FUGITIVE BEING SOUGHT

San Pedro, Calif. — Special Agent in Charge John A. Torres with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), Los Angeles Field Division and the Los Angeles Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in locating a potentially armed and dangerous fugitive, Francisco Flores, who is wanted for federal firearms violations and narcotic violations in connection with ATF investigation, Operation Pirate Town (Rancho San Pedro).

ATF announced today that a \$5,000 reward will be offered for information leading to the successful arrest of Flores. Flores was indicted with others in April by a federal Grand Jury in Los Angeles for his part in trafficking firearms and narcotics. Flores has been a fugitive since April 28, when law enforcement authorities concluded Operation Pirate Town in San Pedro.
