To manage the DoD National Capital Region Mass Transportation Benefit Program for DoD military and civilian personnel applying for and in receipt of fare subsidies.

PII collected is: Name, truncated last 4, Employment information, City, State and Zip+4 of residence, point-to-point commuting expenses, type of mass transit used. Smart Benefit pilot program participants also provide their SmarTrip card number.

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

The risk is that the information provided is obtained by unauthorized individuals. The system resides on a DoD (WHS) network server and is CAC enabled, so that only those with CAC and those with a need-to-know may access and use the site. Applicants/participants may only view their information on the site.
