Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 years Statutory Tour at **1AF/A1R (Tyndall AFB, FL)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **3M05/71**. Duties and Responsibilities: Analyzes, develops, and evaluates detailed plans, goals, and objectives for long-range implementation of assigned major command program(s). Programs relate to one or more of the following tactical or strategic areas: mobilization, exercise, noncombatant evacuation, mortuary search and recovery, acquisition, contingency, and long-range strategy for the beddown of contingency operations, documenting base operating support requirements, developing requirements for the time phased forces deployment data (TPFDD). Analyzes and evaluates substantive program operations, management and organizational effectiveness, efficiency, and productivity. Plans, coordinates, and implements OPLAN taskings and CONOPs, coordinating deployment taskings, to include WRM and operational ration requirements. Study objectives are to improve operations, training and strategy; and to furnish data for higher-level headquarters decisions. This involves analysis of data, determination of the operational implications of statistics generated from the data, and application of results to the requirements process. Develops and recommends modifications to systems and programs around doctrine, tactics, and concepts of operations that track Air Force, OSD, and joint planning documents. Promotes interchange of information on requirements, capabilities, deficiencies, and technology applications in the area of specialization. Analyzes problems discovered in prior studies or actual operations and advises higher levels of management on the feasibility of different approaches which provide a basis for better planning of operations. Primary staff advisor to the COMAFFOR for Services requirements in the adaptive planning. This includes the development of a TPFDD for Services requirements of personnel/equipment. Works in close coordination with the A3/A5 crises action planning functions to ensure comprehensive movement and execution planning during all phases of the campaign including refinement Services force flow, beddown, and redeployment of AF Services assigned/attached forces. Supports the Long Range Planning Group (LRPG) and should have the skills necessary to help develop and refine the commander's estimate, by Courses of Action (COAs), and recommend forces for execution of the COAs. Performs Deliberate planning and Crisis Action planning tasks to include course of action and plan development to OPLANs, CONPLANs, BSPs, contingencies and humanitarian assistance. This is accomplished by preparing functional annexes to applicable plans. Conducts Site Survey and makes recommendations for Services operations at bare base

Beddown operations. Provides services inputs for exercises in AOR. Requires knowledge of TPFDD/JOPEs, and procedures to implement and process the planning and readiness program for the WFHA A7 Services. Acts as the primary advisor to the COMAFFOR for Services and cross-functional expeditionary combat support. Provides focused oversight and operational level planning, policy and resources for services requirements in managing garrison, contingency installations services, mission support activities and serves as the coordinating authority for related issues with other US government agencies. Interfaces for other service Regional Wartime Construction Management (RWCM) support, contracting support, for lease/use of host nation facilities (lodging, food service, recreation and mortuary affairs). Participates/augments the A7 Specialty team as liaison for sustainment operations for exercises and contingencies. Needs working knowledge of WRM Services assets. May be required to man forward headquarters staffs during contingency operations. Determines command staff augmentation requirements using Services UTCs. Supports forward operating location (FOL) requirements for manning assistance, rations, and equipment. Maintains a summary of FOL command and control information and makes the information available to rear staffs, AEFC, MAJCOMs, AFSVA, and AF/ILV. Ensures sites complete weekly situation reports (SITREPS.) Tracks movement of Prime RIBS UTCs for both personnel and equipment from the UTC origin until it reaches the theater destination. Also tracks redeployment from forward operating locations to home station. Performs other duties assigned.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-2503, Paragraph 3.8.

Application for this MVA signifies agreement to the following statement, "I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the information in and attached to this application is true, correct, complete and made in good faith.
