## **Proposed Amendments to Rule 65**

Rule 65 is amended as follows:

Rule 65. Injunctions and Restraining Orders

\* \* \* \* \* \*

(e) <u>Precedence of Motions</u>. Motions seeking temporary or preliminary injunctive relief will be given precedence over other matters pending before the court, and expedited in every way.

## **Advisory Committee Note**

The text of Rule 65 has been amended to state that the Court will expedite motions for temporary or preliminary injunctive relief. A corresponding amendment removed similar language from Rule 3(g). Inserting this language into Rule 65 preserves the Court's express recognition of its obligation to "expedite the consideration . . . [of] any action for temporary or preliminary injunctive relief . . . ." as required by 28 U.S.C. § 1657.
