- To work well together, need to understand each person's personality
 - Effort made to get to know one another and build relationships
 - Time spent away from the lab bench
 - Personality type indicators (Myer's Briggs)
 - Will also help recognize uncharacteristic behaviors
- Use an introductory training period as a screening period by the lab personnel
 - Opportunity to work closely with new candidates and observe work ethic
 - Create a team that works well together
- Conflict Management
 - Disagreements between lab personnel must be addressed and resolved in a sensitive and respectful manner
 - Outside moderator
