From personal experience.....

- PI's should be very proactive in dealing with any complaints about laboratory personnel.
 - Many small complaints about one individual could be an indicator
 - In training what behaviors to look for, also training potential threats "how not" to act
- Action plan in place to deal with complaints
 - Lack of corrective measures taken may discourage the reporting of small things
 - Conflict mediation necessary
