Non-Treatment Evaluations and Command-Directed Procedures

Emergency Command-Directed Behavioral Health Evaluations

(examples: suicidal/homicidal/hallucinations/bizarre behavior)

- 1. Take appropriate safety/risk management measures, such as calling ambulance/police or transporting to ER, if needed.
- 2. Call ABH to speak with Doctoral-Level Provider.
- 3. At earliest opportunity, given risk level, forward paperwork to ABH.
- 4. At earliest opportunity, given risk level, have the Soldier complete "Soldier Notification Memo."
- 5. Escort Soldier to ABH.

Routine Command-Directed Behavioral Health Evaluations

(examples: evaluation for fitness for duty or consideration for AR 635-200, Ch 5-17 separation)

- 1. Call ABH to speak with Doctoral-Level Provider.
- 2. Counsel Soldier and have Soldier complete "Soldier Notification Memo."
- 3. Schedule ABH appointment during conversation with Doctoral-level provider.
- 4. Escort Soldier to ABH on day of appt.

Administrative Behavioral Health Evaluations

(examples: Ch 13, 14 clearance, Drill SGT)

- 1. Call ABH for appt.
- 2. Escort Soldier to appt.
- 3. Soldier should be willing to sign consent of release of the evaluation information
