### Post Description:

Depot 26 provides depot level supply and maintenance for Communication Information System (CIS) under the NATO CIS Services Agency (NCSA), Joint Force Command Headquarters (JFC HQ) Brunssum and ISAF HQ Telecommunication guidance to meet Commander ISAF priorities of CIS supply, repair and asset distribution and to maintain property accountability. Worker is responsible to Chief Warehouse for the supply warehouse tasks.

### Principle Duties:

Helps the Chief Warehouse in all tasks related to warehouse activities to include receipt & dispatch, shipping and locating material on shelves. Will conduct periodic inventory (counting) of depot stocks.

Assist in the accounting for all ISAF owned Communications and Information System (CIS) property at HQ ISAF, Kabul Multi National Brigade (KMNB) and Kabul International Airport (KAIA) and PRT/FSB/RAC in accordance with NCSA instructions.

Responsible for the correct receipt, storage, issue, ordering and stock control of the total supply inventory including repairable and non-repairable communications equipment within the depot. Responsible for the accurate input of information to the NATO Depot Support System (NDSS) computer in order that receipts and issues are processed in accordance with current procedures. Responsible for preparing shipping manifests and co-ordinating shipments to and from Depot 26.

Deputy for the Repair/Exchange Specialist in his absence and must be capable of performing these functions.

Loads and unloads all supply property for the warehouse.

Performs routine and non-routine cleaning requirements for the Warehouse.

Will interact with other depot 26 staff both NATO Civilian and military.

### Additional Duties:

Performs other duties as directed. May be required to travel for official duty within and outside ISAF joint operation area.

Must have experience with automated supply control procedures. Must be competent in the use of Microsoft Outlook application.

Will be provided necessary NDSS training at Depot 26.
