- Created in June 2008 to ensure all available data is analyzed and policies applied when identifying and mitigating FOCI in the NISP
 - Products and processes created as part of DSS response to July 2005 GAO Report, DOD Cannot Ensure Its Oversight of Contractors Under Foreign Influence is Sufficient
 - FAD currently consists of 13 FTEs

Monitoring NISP Facilities

- Created a Portal which continually runs a search of the names of all NISP facilities against various RSS feeds from business news sites
- Findings are analyzed and material changes are reported in NISP in the NEWS
- Published on a weekly basis and sent to all DSS Regional Offices for their cognizance; used to provide oversight of NISP facilities



Identification and Analysis of FOCI Modified Process – Now Reviewing all SF328s

When a Field Office Chief determines an e-FCL package is complete, the FAD is notified to conduct a review of the SF328 to ensure all FOCI has been properly reported.

Beta Test Phased in Roll Out Full Implementation

(May 2010) (June 2010 – January 2011) (February 2011)





Reviewing all Completed e-FCL Packages

Reviewing approximately 250 packages/month

- Approximately 150 comprehensive FOCI Assessments written monthly; distributed to Field Operations and CI
- Facilities analyzed before package receives final clearance approval
 - Packages for facilities already in NISP are also reviewed to ensure proper reporting






