

## MOTION TO RECOMMIT THE BILL H.R. 839

M\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 839 to the Committee on Financial Services with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

In subsection (c)(1) of the matter proposed to be inserted by the amendment made by section 2 of the bill, strike “paragraph (2)” and insert “paragraphs (2) and (5)”.

At the end of section 2 of the bill, strike the closing quotation marks and the last period and add the following new paragraph:

1           “(5) CONTINUATION OF PROGRAM FOR MEM-  
2           BERS OF THE ARMED FORCES AND GOLD STAR RE-  
3           CIPIENTS.—

4           “(A) IN GENERAL.—After the date of the  
5           enactment of this Act and only to the extent  
6           that amounts are made available pursuant to  
7           the authorization of appropriations under sub-  
8           paragraph (C), the Secretary may provide as-  
9           sistance under the Home Affordable Modifica-  
10          tion Program on behalf of any homeowner who

1 otherwise qualifies for assistance under such  
2 Program who is—

3 “(i) a member of the Armed Forces of  
4 the United States on active duty, including  
5 those members on active duty in Iraq or  
6 Afghanistan, or the spouse or parent of  
7 such a member; or

8 “(ii) eligible to receive a Gold Star  
9 lapel pin under section 1126 of title 10,  
10 United States Code, as a widow, parent, or  
11 next of kin of a member of the Armed  
12 Forces person who died in a manner de-  
13 scribed in subsection (a) of such section.

14 “(B) IDENTIFICATION OF AMOUNTS.—Not  
15 later than the expiration of the 180-day period  
16 beginning on the date of the enactment of this  
17 paragraph, the Secretary shall—

18 “(i) determine, in consultation with  
19 the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary  
20 of Veterans Affairs, the amount necessary  
21 to provide assistance under the Home Af-  
22 fordable Modification Program to the per-  
23 sons described under clauses (i) and (ii) of  
24 subparagraph (A); and

1                   “(ii) submit notice of such determina-  
2                   tion to the Congress that specifies such  
3                   amount.

4                   “(C) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIA-  
5                   TIONS.—Effective upon the submission to the  
6                   Congress by the Secretary of the notice re-  
7                   quired under subparagraph (B), there is au-  
8                   thorized to be appropriated, for assistance  
9                   under the Home Affordable Modification Pro-  
10                  gram only for persons described under clauses  
11                  (i) and (ii) of subparagraph (A), the amount  
12                  identified in such notice.”.
