Colonel Lawrence A. Colonel Brundidge received his commission in 1987 from the U.S. Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, Colorado. In 1988, he graduated from undergraduate pilot training at Reese Air Force Base, Texas and has since qualified as an Instructor and/or Evaluator in the C-130E, C-21A and E-3B/C aircraft.
