

Central Plateau, Outer Zone



The outer zone of the Central Plateau is about 65 square miles. Recovery Act funding will be used in this area to support shrinking the active footprint of cleanup to as little as 10 square miles in the center of the site. Work will consist mainly of demolishing facilities and remediating waste sites.




Central Plateau, Outer Zone (~65 sq. mi.)



Central Plateau, Outer Zone (~65 sq. mi.)

- Complete closure plans/design and initiate remediation of Non-Radioactive Dangerous Waste Landfill (NRDWL) and Solid Waste Landfill (SWL)
- NRDWL was used for nonradioactive, hazardous waste (e.g. batteries, old fluorescent lights)
- SWL was used for non-hazardous solid waste (e.g., office refuse)

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
