Dear Chairman Lieberman:

Pursuant to Public Law 110-28, the U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care, Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act, 2007, and the Buy American Act (BAA) (41 U.S.C. 10a) contained therein, I am pleased to submit the Buy American Report for the United States International Trade Commission (USITC) covering Fiscal Year 2008.

(A) The dollar value of any articles, materials, or supplies that were manufactured outside the United States: \$448,827.26

(B) An itemized list of all waivers granted with respect to such articles, materials, or supplies under this Act, and a citation to the treaty, international agreement, or other law under which each waiver was granted: NONE
