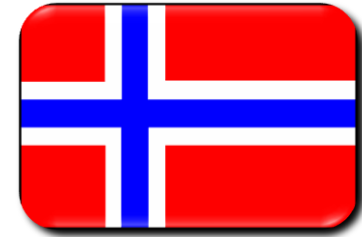




Norway
